





### The individual counts

English Thoroughbreds in the breeding of sport horses – hardly any other topic is as present in breeding discussions as this one; it truly is a perennial issue.

t present, the main complaint in the breed is that the number of mares bred to Thoroughbred stallions continues to decline. At the beginning of March in Verden, at an open round-table discussion on the issue of breeding event horses, Ulrich Hahne, breeding director of the Hannoveraner Verband, shared that, in 2021, only 39 foals by Thoroughbred stallions were registered for the Hannoveraner Verband. This raises the question: Is this a real problem with regard to the quality of our horses or is the use of Thoroughbred stallions actually no longer necessary? With respect to the development of the international sport horse breed, the influence of English Thoroughbreds cannot be valued high enough. Internationally, there is probably no breed that has influenced the breeding of sport horses as much as the Thoroughbred horse has, whose breed was founded in England for racing only. From the beginning, Thoroughbreds were bred for performance. Only what happened on the racetrack counted! In accordance with the statement "Form follows Function", a horse developed with the typical type and exterior features. The English Thoroughbred contributed significantly to the type design of the modern sport horse: The horses became nobler and lighter, the pasterns longer. The topline, which is useful for the sport horse, remained and so did the saddle position with a long, sloping shoulder and pronounced withers. Less favorable – especially for the dressage horse — is the sometimes somewhat low-set neck. These are purely physical characteristics. At least as important are mental characteristics such as intelligence, sensitivity and quickness of reaction – the special spirit – which, together with the Thoroughbred's physique, lead to more athleticism combined with ease of movement.

### The short connection

Arnaud Evain, a well-known breeding expert from France, has summed this up very clearly: "We expect a certain quickness of mind from the Thoroughbred. As a rider once said to me - a short distance between the leg and the brain. A horse can have a long neck or a short neck, but the short connection between your leg and your hand to his brain - that's what we call blood. In the 1970s, only the Thoroughbred had that quality - now we have a lot of warmbloods with the same quality." The quote is from a 2010 article written by the Australian journalist Chris Hector, and published in Breeding News and Eurodressage. With his horse magazine, Chris Hector is a brilliant observer of the international breeding scene. Almost all of the stallion lines used in the Hannoveraner breed today were founded by a Thoroughbred stallion, and successful lines were developed with many Thoroughbred mares. Soon after the General Stud Book - to

which all Thoroughbred horses are traced – was published in England in 1793, the Thoroughbred also conquered continental Europe. In Germany, the first horse race with Thoroughbreds took place in Doberan in 1822, and already in the first half of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, the use of the English Thoroughbred in the Hannoveraner breed reached a peak. In 1841, the share of Thoroughbred stallions at the State Stud Celle was 35 percent. 73 Thoroughbred stallions were in service at the state stud at that time (DER HANNOVERANER 1985). At Celle's stud Otersen, for example, nine stallions stood at stud in 1839, six of which were Thoroughbreds covering 408 out of 509 mares in that year (i.e. about 80 percent). Thus, the English Thoroughbred was anchored in the Hannoveraner lines at an early stage. However, the horses then became too light and the Thoroughbred influence decreased. Around 1900, only three percent of the Celle's state stud sires belonged to the English Thoroughbred breed. At that time, the suitability of the horses for the military was still the top priority. However, they also had to be able to be used for farming, and there was an additional interest in racing. After Germany lost World War I, the military was cut back. More emphasis was placed on the use of horses in farming, which led to a wave of reinforcement. At about the same time, the equestrian sport started to develop with the founding of numerous riding and driving clubs.

Breeding horses experienced a major break during the period after World War II. The motorization in farming started to more and more replace the horses. They now were bred exclusively as riding and sport horses. At this time a refinement phase became necessary, during which primarily English Thoroughbreds were used in Hannover, including stallions such as Der Löwe xx, Marcio xx and Pik As xx, as well as Trakehners and, to a somewhat lesser extent, Anglo-Arabians. The use of Thoroughbred stallions peaked for the first time in 1970, when they covered about eleven percent of all mares. A second peak occurred in 1990, when Thoroughbreds accounted for twelve percent of coverings. One stallion had a large share in this: It was Lauries Crusador xx, born in 1985. At that time, the mark of ten percent was formulated as the desirable share of Thoroughbreds in the coverings.

### The job is done

For more than 60 years, the breeding goal in Hannover has thus been to exclusively produce riding horses. About 30 years ago, with the development of the show jumping program, the specialization primarily for the disciplines of show jumping or dressage started. This exclusive concentration on equestrian sports marked a new era in the bree-

ding of warmblood horses. Gone are the waves of reinforcement. Since then, it exclusively is about the noble, blood-influenced horse. 60 years - which spells six generations, when you consider an average generational interval of ten years in the breeding of horses (Uphaus 1993). You can definitely achieve something in terms of breeding in this time frame. The breeding goals that we aimed for with the use of the Thoroughbred, have largely been achieved. We have succeeded in breeding and consolidating the desired blood-influenced type of horse, which means that this type is safely passed on from one generation to the next. However, this also means that the refinement phase is largely complete.

Dr. Florian Sitzenstock, today a professor in stockbreeding at the Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences, researched how strongly the English Thoroughbred is anchored in the Hannoveraner breed. In 2008, he wrote his doctoral thesis on "Crossing of English Thoroughbred-blood into the Hannoveraner Warmblood population". In an evaluation of the share of Thoroughbred blood in four ancestral generations of foal crops from 1980 to 2006, he found that although the use of Thoroughbred stallions decreased from 11.8 per cent to 3.3 percent in the period from 1992 to 2006, the percentage of Thoroughbred-blood increased from 20 to 25 percent during the period from 1980 to 2006. "In 2006, there were less than one percent of foals whose pedigrees did not contain an English Thoroughbred, while this was the case for 15 percent of foals born in 1980." The situation is similar in Germany's neighboring countries. In the already mentioned article of Chris Hector, Arnaud Evain describes the situation in France: "Today there are sport horses that do not have a Thoroughbred ancestor in the first three generations, but they still have a lot of blood. If you look at the pedigrees of French horses, the percentage of Thoroughbreds has stabilized between 15 and 20 percent, a situation which is similar in the Netherlands." He draws an interesting comparison, fitting for France as a country, which enjoys the pleasures in life: "If you mix a drink with 20 percent of alcohol with another with 20 percent of alcohol, you still have 20 percent of alcohol. It is the same with our horses. We breed a horse with 20 percent of Thoroughbred blood to another horse with 20 percent and get the same share of Thoroughbred blood."

### New definition of a blood horse

Now this is an interesting point. In most stallions and mares, some Thoroughbred percentage is anchored in the back of the pedigrees and many positive characteristics of the blood horse have been preserved. So one attains a whole new definition of a blood horse. Paul Schockemöhle describes his top sires Sandro Hit (one Thoroughbred ancestor, Sacramento Song xx, born in 1967, in the third generation) and Diarado (two Thoroughbred ancestors in the fourth generation: Amarpour xx, born in 1966, and Rantzau xx, born in 1946) as blood horses, which definitely pass on the characteristics of a blood-influenced horse. The Hannoveraner stallions Perigueux (not a Thoroughbred in the first four generations, but further back) and Escudo (a Thoroughbred ancestor: Novum xx, born 1957, in the fourth generation) would also fit into the same category, as they have proven their refining potential through their heredity. In this re-


### Asking the experts

**Dr. Bonny-Jasmin Jacobs** and her father are among the largest and most successful breeders of show jumpers in Hannover: "The use of Thoroughbred stallions is dif-

ficult for us, as we primarily breed to market the offspring directly. However, I make sure that there is enough blood in the third generation, both in the mares and the stallions. Furthermore, it is important to us that the stallions are light enough."

**For Hannes Baumgart**, a member of the Hannoveraner dressage licensing commission, a dressage horse breeder and trainer up to Grand Prix, the refinement process is com-

plete: "We have so much noble blood in the lines that it is difficult to use a pure Thoroughbred. It has to be an exceptional Thoroughbred, which shows under saddle what the



**Norbert Bramlage,** a private stallion owner and co-founder of the Association for Privately-Owned Hannoveraner Stallion Owners and a successful breeder, is basically a great friend of the Thoroughbred horse. From the stallions at his station, the Thoroughbred stallion Roncalli xx certainly holds a special position. With his sister Rafale xx, Bramlage



built up a new dam line that has produced show jumpers and dressage horses up to the advanced level. "The refinement process is actually complete. Today you see beautiful and typy horses that carry no Thoroughbred blood.

But I have to say, something is missing in both the breeding of show jumpers and of dressage horses, when the share of Thoroughbred blood diminishes.



Show jumping is getting faster and faster, the dressage tests are getting more demanding because of the different movements that follow each other very quickly. If you gard, Celle's State Stud Manager Dr. Axel Brockmann raves about his young stallion Doom Pur by Doom SR/Aktion Pur DB Z, which he purchased at Verden's licensing in 2021: "He is super light, agile, fast in his reflexes and can be used like a blood horse." Yet he doesn't have a Thoroughbred in the first generations. So there are definitely Hannoveraner, Holstein and Oldenburg stallions as well as stallions from other Warmblood populations that can be used as refining sires. Looking at the breeding values in his dissertation, Dr. Florian Sitzenstock found out that the aptitude and conformation for dressage were positively influenced by an increasing share of Thoroughbred blood. This effect became particularly evident when the share of Thoroughbred blood was found in the generation of the grandparents. Regarding the breeding values for jumping, there was, however, a clearly negative correlation between the breeding values and the share of Thoroughbred blood. This result should not be generalized, as it was due to the unique situation in Hannover. The most important Thoroughbred stallions of the study period were Lauries Crusador xx, Prince Thatch xx and Sunlight xx - all stallions that had been used because of their movement, type and conformation and mainly brought positive impulses to the breeding of dressage horses.

It is interesting to look at the share of Thoroughbreds in the first four generations of each of the top 100 dressage and show-jumping horses in the FEI World Rankings (year-end 2021). The basis for this are the pedigrees, which can be found on the internet at www.Horsetelex.de. There, the share of Thoroughbred blood is shown, which is calculated

over nine generations. Ancestors who belonged to the refining breeds like the English Thoroughbred, Anglo Arabian or Arabian Thoroughbred breed were taken into account.

Dressage: (five Lusitanos or PRE were not counted)

- 31 horses (32.3 percent) had no Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian genetics in the first four gene-
- 51 (53.2 percent) horses had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) in the fourth generation at the earliest.
- Eleven horses (11.5 percent) had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) in the third generation at the earliest.
- Only three horses (3.1 percent) had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) already in the second generation. These were Bella Rose (Isabell Werth) as well as the two Hannoveraner horses Faustus (Dorothee Schneider) and Statesman (Naima Moreira Laliberte, Canada).
- No horse had a Thoroughbred/Anglo-Arabian as its sire or dam.

A good 85 percent of the horses therefore either have no Thoroughbred or only one or more ancestors in the fourth generation at the earliest. Nevertheless, according to Horsetelex (i. e. calculated over nine generations), the medium share of refining blood is 33.4 percent. Only the abovementioned five Spanish horses show a refining share of zero; in the other horses, it varies between 17.97 percent (Fürst Ferdinand zur Fasanenhöhe, bred in Bavaria and number 94 in the world rankings) and 51.76 percent for the already menti-

want to be successful in the big sport today, you need a horse that immediately knows what you want, it must be able to anticipate. For that we need the blood horse. The blood horse, however, requires fine handling and a fine way of riding. I have Roncalli xx in my breeding program now in the 4th/5th generation and will now use bloodstock again to improve body mobility and constitution besides the required intelligence. The stallion that I am going to use, must have the desired qualities himself. Therefore - it is always about the individual. We do not need the Thoroughbred per se, but the special one, the clever one. Unfortunately, a lot of generalization often takes place, which, by the way, does not only apply to Thoroughbred horses but also to other breed populations."

The state stud always viewed as its responsibility to provide Thoroughbred stallions for refinement purposes. Does that still hold true? Dr. Axel Brockmann, state stud

manager in Celle: "I would love to stand a new Thoroughbred stallion, but it has become difficult to find the right one. I am mostly offered stallions that didn't work out on the racetrack. However, I have a good working relationship with Dr. Astrid von Velsen-Zerweck in Marbach. She focusses on finding Thoroughbreds and Anglo-Arabians and making them available. When I for in-

stance look at the Herwart von der Decken-

Show, or look around at rural shows, we are

well positioned in terms of type. We no longer need the Thoroughbred for refinement. The breeder of jumpers wants to have powerful horses. In dressage horse breeding, the Thoroughbred as a refining stallion is in tough competition with the Trakehner stallion, who was selected because of his basic gaits and his rideability."

Among the state studs, the Marbach Main and State Stud holds a special position, as Dr. Astrid von Velsen-Zerweck, the stud's manager, explains: "We specialize in refining stallions - Anglo-Arabians, Thoroughbred Arabians, Trakehners but also English Thoroughbreds – for the refinement and further development of Warmblood breeds. Marbach has always been home to blood horses. So

oned Statesman by Sandro Hit/Brentano II, whose maternal grandam is a Thoroughbred mare.

Jumping (an Irish horse was not included because the maternal lineage was not available):

- 5 horses (25.3 percent) had no Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian genetics in the first four generations
- 51 horses (51.5 percent) had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) in the fourth generation at the earliest.
- 20 horses (20.2 percent) had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) in the third generation at the earliest.
- Three horses (3 percent) had one or more refining ancestors (Thoroughbred or Anglo-Arabian) already in the second generation. These were two Selle Français-horses with a high share of Anglo-Arabian blood and one horse with Irish breeding, where traditionally a lot of Thoroughbreds were used in breeding show jumpers.
- No horse had a Thoroughbred/Anglo-Arabian as sire or dam.

According to the data from Horsetelex, a mean percentage for refinement of 43 percent was calculated, which is almost ten percent higher than in dressage horses. The range was between 19.92 percent for the purely Hannoveraner-bred King Edward (number 2 in the world rankings, Henrik von Eckermann) and 61.52 percent for the Selle Français gelding Usual Suspect d'Auge, who was ridden by Julien Epaillard, among others. This evaluation shows how much refining blood accumulates further back in the pedigrees; and that in top competitions in the disciplines of dressage and jumping, positive effects of the blood-influence often become apparent after three or four generations. There is no need to analyze the refining blood components of top event horses, because here it is clear: Without Thoroughbred blood, it does not work. This was also made very clear at the above-

mentioned discussion meeting on the subject of eventing at the beginning of March in Verden. Although there are more and more horses in eventing where the Thoroughbred blood is not found in the first generation, there is a clear tendency that the more difficult the competitions are, the higher the percentage of Thoroughbred blood is. Trainer Jörn Warner researched this in his thesis. He found that the share of Thoroughbred blood in horses that are successful in the lower levels of eventing is lower (less than 30 percent) than in horses that are successful at the four- and five-star levels (more than 40 percent). Dr. Henning Frevert, the state stud manager of Neustadt/Dosse, formulated a model for the breeding value estimation for event horses as his thesis in 2016. He also found a positive correlation between the share of Thoroughbred blood and the success in international eventing competitions.

The general conditions for the use of Thoroughbred stallions have changed fundamentally over the past decades. The Thoroughbred has done a super job as a refining stallion for dressage and jumping, making itself to some extent superfluous. The decline in demand for Thoroughbred stallions is an indication of the successful refinement process, which is logical and no reason to panic. Eventing will not be possible in the future without the influence of Thoroughbred blood. For the breeding of dressage and show-jumping horses, it will be interesting to see whether a blood refreshment is sensible and necessary after a few generations. "Boosting" with Thoroughbreds is the new buzzword. Therefore, the English Thoroughbred will remain part of the breeding program for the Hannoveraner and the Rhineland riding horse. However, fewer stallions will be needed, but the quality demands will increase, also due to the specialization. The breeders' demands regarding the basic gaits and the rideability or regarding the jumping ability have become greater.

### Asking the experts

this is nothing new, just a strengthening of what was already there. Our breeders are very open to refinement. We also cooperate with other state studs such as Celle or



Schwaiganger, but also with private stallion owners. For example, we accepted Asagao xx, who passed his test in Marbach, in our program from the very beginning. In my opinion, the Thoroughbred has a place in the breeding of sport horses in the future, but not indiscri-

minately and not always. What is interesting about the Thoroughbred is the special composition of the muscular fibers, which is interesting for eventing, but also for dressage and jumping. Willingness to perform, willingness to fight, elasticity of movement, stamina and quick responsiveness are promoted by using Thoroughbred blood. I am cautious when it comes to health, because often Thoroughbreds are offered that were expelled from racing at an early age. One must absolutely question this. The breeders of event horses are the ones who pay the most atten-

tion to having enough blood. You certainly can't do without blood there. In the disciplines of dressage and jumping, the future will show whether it is necessary to refresh the blood every now and then. I also recommend certain Thoroughbreds for these two disciplines. Il Divo xx, for example, has proven to be a good refining stallion for dressage horses. The Thoroughbred stallion Waugh xx is a relatively new addition. He himself jumps well. Dam's sire Monsun xx has made a name for himself in England as the sire of horses with jumping talent."

### Ulrich Hahne: "We need refinement in the heads!"

Eventing was written in capital letters in Verden at the beginning of March. For the first time, a show jumping competition with fixed obstacles took place in the Niedersachsenhalle. At the same time, the renowned rider and trainer Jörn Warner gave a three-day clinic. In the evening, interested breeders, riders and trainers discussed the breeding of event horses and the use of Thoroughbred stallions.

One of the best event horses at the moment is the Nobre xx/Heraldik xx-daughter FRH Butt's Avondale (breeder: Prof. Dr. Volker Steinkraus, Ollsen). The bay with an almost pure Thoroughbred pedigree comes from the Hannoveraner Halfbred racehorse line of Ordalie. The foundation mares have been consistently bred to Thoroughbred stallions since the year of origin in 1888. With Anna Siemer, the State's Premium candidate collected successes from the Bundeschampionat to the World Championships for Young Event Horses up to team silver at the European Championships last year in Avenches/SUI. Her rider commented on videos of the rides in Warendorf and in Switzerland -ten years lie between them almost to the day. "Even as a young horse, FRH Butt's Avondale liked to gallop," she shared. "She always has the tiger in the tank," said Anna Siemer. "Sometimes the high share of Thoroughbred blood presented a hindrance, because she just did not want to trot. But she was incredibly tough. She is 15 years old and still has crystal clear legs."

Eight years ago, Jörn Warner examined the percentage of Thoroughbred blood in the pedigrees of successful event horses. The State Stud Celle supplied him with information for his thesis. He came to the following conclusion: "We need blood in our sport! This is not quite as important at the lower levels, but gains in importance from four-star competitions onward. Overall, the German horse has become more interesting internationally in recent years." The fact that many of the warmblood stallions in service have a higher share of blood themselves, is conducive. The influence of Thoroughbred stallions has decreased rapidly in Hannover: Whereas 20 years ago about 500 halfbred foals were born, ten years later, there only were about 100. In 2021, 39 foals were born whose sire's name

ended with the appendix xx or AA. "In the offspring of Thoroughbred stallions, no improvement in basic gaits or in jumping can be expected in the first generation," said breeding director Ulrich Hahne. This becomes a problem when these horses are to be sold at a young age. Breeders rarely wait eight years or more for competition successes to set in. In the meantime, the selection of stallions is not so much about the use of Thoroughbreds, but about the qualities that are attributed to them: strength, toughness and willingness to perform. These are qualities that even non-Thoroughbreds can pass on. "When we look for a Thoroughbred stallion today, it is a different one compared to two decades ago," said Ulrich Hahne. "He has to bring stability in the foundation and for jumping." At the same time, the current sires are much lighter and more blood-influenced than 20 years

"We have to make sure that we keep enough substance in the foundation. Our horses are already ,beautiful' and ,refined'. We no longer need the refinement in the body, but in the head." Dr. Ludwig Christmann agrees: "The refining phase in Hannover is over," said the long-standing head of the Hannoveraner Verband's international breeding department. "But that doesn't mean that we don't need Thoroughbreds any more, just different ones." Using Thoroughbred blood is also interesting, when it appears on the mare side. "The best way is to breed a correct Thoroughbred mare to a jumper producer and

not to go for a Thoroughbred stallion," said Prof. Dr. Gerhard Sybrecht, who was not only a successful event rider, but also dedicated himself to breeding horses with his wife Ulrike. The idea was successful: FRH Eskadia by Escudo/Groom Dancer xx at the time was fourth in the World Championships for Young Event Horses with rider Andreas Dibowski. Anna Siemer agreed: "Not every Thoroughbred is suitable for breeding riding horses." The female rider has also repeatedly had young talents in her stable for training over the past years, whose pedigrees would also attract the interest of dressage horse breeders. "In my experience, this only goes up to the two-star level," she says and sees problems with the durability due to a generally unfavorable movement sequence when jumping, especially when landing. The Bundeschampionat are a springboard for numerous international careers. Both Contendro offspring, fischerChipmunk FRH (breeder: Dr. Hilmer Meyer-Kulenkampff, Behlmer), who has a Halfbred dam named Havanna by Heraldik xx, and FRH Corrida (breeder: Dr. Rainer Zurmaar, Ehlscheid), who has almost no Thoroughbred blood, won gold in Warendorf and are currently the most successful Hannoveraner eventing horses internationally worldwide. In August of last year, the Don Index/Rotspon-daughter Das Fräulein Inge FRH (breeder: Peter Broers, Großefehn) was acclaimed as Bundeschampioness. "You never know if the horses that win ribbons in Warendorf, will last long enough," someone said who knows the sport intimately. Elmar Lesch's own list of successes from eventing competitions to Nations Cups is long, and numerous event horses change hands via his sales events. "These are mostly versatile horses, but not event horses."

The market for Halfbreds is clear. Last year in Germany, the number of international eventing competitions was limited. There were two CCI1\* competitions; one could compete at the two-star level 21 times, twelve times at the three-star level and three times at the four-star level. In addition, there is the highlight when Luhmühlen becomes the centre of the eventing scene in the summer with hosting the CCI5\*. It looks very differently in dressage and jumping. "The biggest challenge is to find people who are ready to invest in foals," Ulrich Hahne summed up. BZ

Leipzig, where they delivered a promising start placing eleventh in the first qualification (1.60 metres).

The 2007-born bay, who goes back to the Hessian mare Prinzessin, was the 1,000<sup>th</sup> horse to find a new owner at an auction of the Hannoveraner Verband in 2011. At the Alsfeld Advent, the Werndl family from Aubenhausen secured the top-class horse. With Jessica von Bredow-Werndl and her brother Benjamin Werndl, Havanna was victorious up to the Grand Prix-level before Ashley Holzer took over the reins five years ago. At the age of 25, FRH Butts Abraxxas passed away. "He was still fit and lively, but an acute, age-related heart failure made us decide to not let him suffer. We owe countless moments of happiness to this little fighter with his huge heart," Ingrid Klimke wrote on social media. With the riding master, "Hannover's fastest pony" was one of the most successful event horses of his time. In Hong Kong and London, the pair won team gold at the Olympics. In addition, they won the title at the European Championships in front of their home crowd in Luhmühlen and competed at the World Equestrian Games in Kentucky. Apart from the German Championship-title in 2009, FRH Butts

Abraxxas was not able to achieve big, individual successes. Too often the dreams of winning a medal burst during his performance on the stadium course. In 2013, he finished fourth at the classic event in Burghley, one year later Ingrid Klimke retired her Braxxi from international competitions in Luhmühlen.

FRH Butts Abraxxas by Heraldik xx/Kronenkranich xx was born on May 22,1997 at the farm of the legendary breeder Friedrich Butt in Bülkau. With Albert Habermann, he participated twice in the Bundeschampionat in Warendorf before he came to Ingrid Klimke as a seven-year-old. Chris Bartle and Hans Melzer, the German national trainers at the time, had discovered his talent. Like Andreas Dibowski's FRH Butts Avedon and Anna Siemer's FRH Butt's Avondale, his pedigree starts with the foundation mare Ordalie. Before the bay finally "retired", he was eagerly competing with Ingrid Klimke's daughter Greta Busacker and enabled her to make the transition from a pony to a big horse. "After being completely retired, Braxxi spent seven more wonderful years with us in the stable in his box stall number one and in the pasture with his best friend Weiße Düne. We are very sad and miss him! Braxxi, you will always have a special place in our hearts!" Britta Züngel

## For 25 years a fixed date



In 1997, the first free jumping competition of the Hannoveraner jumper breeding programme took place. In the meantime, it has become a fixed date on the calendar and was one of the first public appearances for numerous horses that later enjoyed an international career.

wice the free jumping competition had to be cancelled: Once because of the outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease, and, two years ago, because of Covid-19. The Niedersachsenhalle presented itself in a new look. The free jumping lane was shortened and was framed by attractive barriers. A clever set-up guided the horses while free-running from round to round. 59 three-year-olds competed. All 34 four-year-old talents, which were listed in the catalog, participated. The competition was divided according to performance. The judge was the successful show jumper Lars Meyer zu Bexten, who is now in demand worldwide as a trainer and show organizer. "Being a judge at the free jumping competition in Verden was a first for me and a lot of fun. The atmosphere in the arena was fabulous. The communication with the other two judges was excellent. It was nice to see how many modern and motivated horses were presented." With him, breeding director Ulrich Hahne and Thomas Schönig, who has been present at the free jumping competition for many years as a show jumping expert on Verden's auction team, judged technique, scope and jumping intelligence.

With the highest score of the day, Goldfüchschen V won the gold medal and the title in the division for three-year-olds. The typy Zendine/Calido-son impressed with his light-footedness and high elasticity. He used his entire body, when he jumped and moved. With a super clean front leg technique, he obtained 27.9 points as the final result. "He very quickly handled the atmosphere very well and stood out positively from the first moment. In addition, he checks off many points regarding what one would like to see in a modern show jumper," said Lars Meyer zu Bexten appreciatively. It could not have gone better for the breeders Julia and Sebastian Vossmann from Engelschoff; it was their first participation in the free jumping competition. Goldfüchschen V is a Hannoveraner offspring of the successful Holstein dam line 3488, which produced in addition to Sohn der Erde K, a successful participant in the World Championships for Young Jumpers, Hans-Dieter Dreher's Cool and Easy and Hans-Thorben Rüders' Orlanda. Next to the winner's sash and the blanket, the breeders enioyed receiving a stud fee voucher for Celle's state stud stallion Doom Pur.

Second place in the first division was awarded to the Conthargos/Comte-mare Coco (breeder/exhibitor: Marc Kottke, Kutenholz). The beautiful, dark bay mare radiated motivation and willingness to perform. Equipped with very good technique, she

scored a total of 26.8 points. In the front of her pedigree is the foundation dam Cadarina. Celle's state stud sire Viscount and the privately owned stallion Caroly, the Bundeschampion of five-yearold show jumpers, also go back to this dam. And of course Stella, who jumped from success to success with Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum, as well as Prestige, Franke Sloothaak's Olympic horse from Barcelona, and the unforgettable Garlic with rider Heinrich-Wilhelm Johannsmann. Campina by Chacfly PS/Contendro (breeder and exhibitor: ZG Abel, Bremervörde) also has Olympic relatives. With very even rounds, which reflected great scope, she placed third with 26.2 points. Her dam, which successfully competed with the breeder's daughter Pia Katharina Abel in show jumping classes up to 1.40 metres and was awarded the title Performance Mare Jumping, is the right sister of NZB Campino. The bay out of the Sporthaus-line won team bronze for New Zealand at the Olympics in London 2012 with eventing icon Mark Todd.

Diacocoram by Diamant de Semilly/Contendro (breeder and exhibitor: Dr. Hilmer Meyer-Kulenkampff, Behlmer) was the winner of the second division with 27.8 points, just a tenth of a second behind this year's champion. Clearly influenced by his dam's sire Contendro – like so many show jumpers in Hannover – he impressed with his scope and overview and received a score of 9.5 for his jumping power, just like Goldfüchschen V. His halfbrother Dexter by Diarado recently moved into a box stall in Warendorf, where he is a member of the German perspective group for eventing with Calvin Böckmann. Dam Chanel jumped herself into the Hannoveraner jumper breeding programme with an excellent mare performance test result. Sofia Lolita by Stolzenberg/Valentino finished with a score of 26.7. The liver chestnut mare out of the line of Flaumblüte was extremely clever over fences. For many years, her breeder Stefan Kleine from Warmsen has been sending high-quality offspring to the free jumping competition. Sofia Lolita's halfsister Hann.Pr.A. Chiara Lolita placed third in the three-year-old class last year and competed in the Herwart von der Decken-Show four months later. She was also present this year, but could not place in the four-year-old class. It was exactly ten years ago that Stefan Kleine celebrated his greatest success to date in the Niedersachsenhalle, when St. Pr.A. Chantal by Chacco-Blue/Conteur won the class for three-year-olds. A son of Clinton's Heart/ Diacontinus – bred by Claudia Bader in Asselingen - made it onto the podium placing third with a score of 25.9 points. Raised in Hunnesrück, the im-

His dam Hann.Pr.St. Djuri (breeder: Peter von der Fecht-Ehlers, Kehdingbruch) had enraptured the judges at her mare performance test and received an even 10 for her scope. The line of llythia has 54 offspring with successes at the S-level, including the privately-owned sire Cashman, Tina Deuerer's Smint and Sheila, who carried Daniel Deußer and Franke Sloothaak to successes in World Cup-show jumping competitions and Nation Cups.

Third best of the vintage from 2019 and thus the winner of the third division was Ogano's Cornetta by Ogano Sitte/Cornet Obolensky (breeder and exhibitor: Wilhelm Gößling, Börger) out of the dam line of Gotenprobe. She scored a total of 27.4 points and collected the highest score awarded on the day, a 9.6 for technique. She jumped to the top with great ambition. She also is the daughter of a mare that impressed at the Herwart von der Decken-Show. As the best jumping mare in Neuversen, St.Pr.St. Corny was awarded the Ic-prize in Verden. She also already proved her hereditary strength. Her son Paul Walker by Periqueux, born in 2011, spent his youth in Hunnesrück, the farm for raising stallions. As a three-year-old, he placed fifth in the free jumping competition and then sold at the elite auction in October of 2015. By now he

pursues an international career with British rider Matthew Sampson obtaining top placings in 1.50 metre-jumping competitions. Pina Colada is one year younger. Katja von der Lieth discovered her at the broodmare auction. After the birth of her foal by Kannan, who by now participates in jumping horse-classes, she now participates in show jumping competitions up to 1.40 metres.

"She wants to get to the other side," Lars Meyer praised the Glasgow van't Merelsnest/Cornet Obolensky-daughter Gabrielle Chanel KHR, who received 26.5 points and placed second. She is another gem from the breeding program of Karl-Henning Rollwage in Bockenem. Last year, the brown was awarded an la-prize in Hauhausen with her dam St.Pr.St. Coco Chanel and her sister Hann.Pr.St. La Cuore KHR by Lordanos. Both participated in the



Lars Meyer zu Bexten: "The free-jumping provides for a good first impression of the jumping ability. Personally I view it as advantageous in young horses, if we combine the free-jumping with an under-saddle test. That is very helpful. I was very pleased today that the majority of horses were bigger framed than in previous years. The breeders in Hannover are on the right track."



Herwart von der Decken-Show; La Cuore KHR also placed sixth in the free-jumping competition in 2017. To this impressive lineup, we must add brother Stakkolensky, who was awarded the Stakkato-Prize, and Quornet KHR by Quaid, who was successful over 1.40 metres. The third-placed horse, Comme il faut etrè by Comme il faut NRW/ Stanley, who was born on the island in the North Sea called Norderney at the farm of Elke and Claudia Tegtmeyer, surpassed herself. She collected 25.8 points, when she jumped like a rubber ball and with great ambition. Her dam Seaside had already jumped into third place in the freejumping competition.

In the class for four-year-olds, Quantico and Bibi Blocksberg delivered a neck-and-neck race. In the end, the Qualito/Corlensky G-son Quantico (breeder: Ulrike Artzenroth, Seevetal) took the lead by a tenth of a point. He solved the tasks with incredible ease, was wide awake and won with 27.2 points. "We will definitely see him again in difficult jumping competitions," Lars Meyer zu Bexten said with certainty. "His entire performance reflected superiority and intelligence." His owner Giuseppe Quintale from Italy had trusted the recommendation of customer advisor Birgit Schröppel at the foal auction in 2018 and bought the bay out of the line of Jumga. Raised on the farm of the Klintworth family in Ohrensen, Quantico matured into a modern show jumper. He inherited his scope from his dam, who received an even 10 for her jumping skills at her mare performance test. The exhibitor's reward was a stud fee voucher from Stutteri Ask. The Danish stud is represented in Germany by the station of Mandes Verhaag in Heuerßen. Second place in the first division was awarded to a horse from the successful breeding program of the Jacobs family. Horses from Bierbergen are regularly among the best in the Niedersachsenhalle. This time it was Camelot PJ by Colman/Escudo who finished second in the first division with 27.0 points. The light-footed and athletic bay was super at the oxer and had long not reached his full potential. Mother Evita was awarded a 10 for free-jumping at her mare performance test. Half-sister Cutie PJ by Chacfly PS had been fourth in the division for three-year-olds earlier. Already one step further along are Camelot's siblings Qui Rit PJ by Quintender and Special One by Stakkato. They already collected international merits in advanced-level jumping competitions. Hann.Pr.A. Kan have Fun by Kannan/Darco (breeder and exhibitor: Jan Crome-Sperling, Lutter a. Bbg.) won bronze. She handled the free-jumping chute in a very clever way and with great ease and travelled to Verden with a 10 for her scope at the mare performance test. Granddam St.Pr.St. Fetzi had already placed fifth in the



Quantico by Qualito/Corlensky G was best four-year-old.

Niedersachsenhalle. With Luciana Diniz' Fit for Fun, she set a monument for herself. Her full brother Flight of Ikarus celebrated a victory in the free-jumping competition in 2009, and half-sister Hann.Pr.St. Cadoria did the same in 2014. The dam of this success is the foundation mare Willkür, who has almost 70 successful, advanced (S)-level show jumpers to her name.

The Balou Peggio/Perigeux-daughter Bibi Blocksberg (breeder: Dr. Frauke Hopp, Schülldorf, exhibitor: Vivian Schult, Wanna) won the second division with 27.1 points. The bay presented herself with a lot of self-confidence and is equipped with a very correct style. She distinguished herself with guickness and a powerful push-off – qualities that her dam's sire Periqueux passed on to her. ATC's Columbia scored 26.9 points placing second exhibiting great superiority. Breeder and exhibitor Karl Griese from Visselhövede had relied on blood that has proven itself for more than two decades. Sire Colman was born in 1996, dam Zarina by Zacharias was born in 1999. The success proved him right. Already last year ATC's Columbia was in the Niedersachsenhalle. At that time she still was a bit "green" and could not yet apply her full potential. The Szenario/Rabino-son Saint Louis (breeder and exhibitor: Jürgen Mahnke, Müden) finished in third place with a score of 26.1. The chestnut gelding left no question as to his scope and jumped with great elasticity. His movements went through his entire body. His dam Ravalla already passed on her excellent genes before to her very first foal, the premium stallion Providence by Provider, who competed in advanced-level show jumping classes with Markus Beerbaum and Karl Brocks before he was sold to Spain.



# For world-class competition

Two breeding horses from Wilhelm Harling's stable in Sottrum are currently making headlines on international show grounds: Divina Royal in the dressage ring and Büttner's Minimax in the advanced show-jumping ring.

n the tranquil property in Sottrum, Wilhelm Harling's precious breeding horses enjoy idyllically laid-out paddocks between many trees or spacious box stalls, which are directly attached to the residential house. "My doors are always open to the neighborhood. I like to have contact with other people. Children and young people are magically attracted to the beautiful four-legged friends," is how the communicative 71-year-old describes his attitude towards life. Probably because he felt the same way in his childhood. "Animals have always fascinated me. At some point, I counted that I owned 34 different kinds of animals, from mice to reptiles. Horses, however, were the ultimate for me."

The horse breeder grew up right next door in a family home that had nothing to do with horses. "My parents supported me in my passion for animals, but as I still had four younger siblings, they were not in a position to finance a horse or riding for me." So the young Wilhelm Harling spent more time on the farms in the area than at home. "I helped the farmers with the harvest on the carriages and sat on cold-blooded horses," the retiree remembers. But there was no question of riding at that time. This is probably why Wilhelm Harling left school at a very early age and began his professional career with the police at the age of 16. "I bought a pony from my first salary. Due to my inexperience, however, it was not so well suited for the sport." In order to learn how to ride, he applied to the police riding squad in Hannover again and again until he finally was accepted and got the job. "As a 20-year-old, I sat on a real horse for the first time, learned how to ride and then

taught myself a lot more." It was a point in time that was to bring about groundbreaking changes for Wilhelm Harling. "I met my wife and almost at the same time got the chance to buy my current property, which happened to be right next to my parents' house."

### It all started with Elja

Alongside the wedding and the move to the new home in 1976, Wilhelm Harling's ongoing ordeal with his spine began, which continues to this day. "Several operations have repeatedly prevented me from going the way that I would have liked to." Especially in terms of riding, the horse lover had to cut back. A career as a professional rider was out of the question. After his training and three years with the Riding Squad Hannover, Wilhelm Harling remained with the police until his retirement. In 1973 he took the opportunity to buy the 14-year-old Eljen/Dolman-daughter Elja (breeder: Heinrich Mau, Großenwörden), who was removed from the service with the riding squad. This was the beginning of his breeding station in Sottrum. As it is so often the case, the first decisions of prospective horse breeders turn out to be correct in retrospect.

Almost 50 years later, the bloodline of Elja is part of today's dam line. The Hannoveraner blood of Alite from 1910 is maintained. At the age of 16, Elja had her first filly, Wabrina by Windsor. Three years later Patrick by Pikoer was born in Sottrum. The gelding later got a foreign owner and successfully competed in dressage at the M-level with Dagmar Helmich. In 1980, the grey mare Pietty Girl (the breeder's spelling mistake, she

should actually be called Pretty Girl) was born. Her sire was Celle's state stud stallion Pikoer. Pietty Girl also exhibited dressage talent and remained in the broodmare herd. Her daughter Aisha by Atatürk celebrated World Cup-successes in Bernhard Wendt's four-in-hand team.

### **Olympic Honors**

Four generations later, the mare Recerka by Royal Highness/Consul (2005) gave birth to the filly Divina Royal by Desperados. This mare is a perfect success story for the breeding farm of Family Harling. "She can hardly be surpassed in dynamics, impulsion, elasticity and charisma," so the verdict of the then Deputy Breeding Director Ulrich Hahne at the 2013 mare show in Sottrum. Logical consequence: Divina Royal was chosen as the winner. In 2014, the chestnut mare was auctioned off to Spain on Verden's November auction. There she competed in international dressage horse classes with Carlos Nieto Benavides, before José Antonio Garcia Mena took over the reins. Divina Royal made her grand entrance in the final of the dressage team competition at the Olympic Games in Tokyo. The plan had been for her to be the substitute horse; however, she was used for the Spanish team and placed 19th. At the European Championships in Hagen in the same year, the mare finished on a very good eleventh place in the freestyle. Formally,

Wilhelm Harling's daughter Janina Weinheimer is the breeder of the exceptional mare. "Janina had a heart for horses from the beginning, but was more interested in riding than in breeding. She started many of our horses, once I could no longer do so." With the grey mare Chiarezza by Consul/ Alexis, the great-granddam of Divina Royal, the 43-year-old was well on her way to gaining a foothold in dressage competitions at the S-level, but decided to make her professional career as a tax consultant a priority.

"As a rule, I try to sell the horses that I breed as three- or four-year-olds. In the past years, however, I have also offered for sale some foals on Verden's auctions. Selling is not really my world, so Verden is a suitable marketing venue for me." Since the beginning of his breeding career, more than 30 horses changed owners through the Hannoveraner Verband. Wilhelm Harling proved his breeding competence when he bought the mare Alenja by Antaeus/Acord II as a foal in 2000. "I specifically commissioned Alenja from the breeder Hans-Hermann Tietjen because the bloodlines of the stallions Don Juan and Atatürk are combined in the pedigree of Alenja's dam Donna Diva."

Cornado turned out to be the perfect combination. The result was the top horse Büttner's Minimax. Alenja is in top condition and is still used for breeding at the age of 22. The highly talented show jumper Büttner's Minimax is currently the top horse in the stable of team World champion Janne-Friedrike Meyer-Zimmermann. Numerous successes in Grand Prix are on Büttner's Minimax' show record. After one of his first victories in 2017 in the Championships of Donaueschingen, the Olympic rider raved about the abilities of the grey horse: "Happy and self-confident, Büttner's Minimax galloped through the jump-off and was able to efficiently deal with the distances thanks to his great canter. He simply inspires with his tremendous jumping ability." He kept the entire world elite at bay in Berlin during the Global Champions Tour. The lifetime earnings of Büttner's Minimax now amount to a sum in Euros in the high six-figures. His sister Coco Mademoiselle by Clinton II, born in 2011, is also successful in S-level show jumping competitions with female rider Daniele Isaia from Italy.

The third bloodline of the Harling breeding program goes back to the Thoroughbred mare Ino xx by Echion xx/Mon Fils xx. "I was looking for refinement in my breeding program and bought Ino xx as a foal directly from the breeder in 1986." Ino xx delivered Alfa Romeo by Atatürk, born in 1992, who was successful in advanced (S)- level show jumping competitions. Her daughter Fifty Fifty by Falkland gave birth to Spartakus by Schwarzenegger in 2006, who is causing a sensation in the sport of dressage successfully competing at Grand Prix in the USA with the American rider Carrie O'Neill. With the home-bred mares Santa Venezia by San Amour/Schwarzenegger, the Franziskus-daughters Flora and Fioretta as well as Alenja, the current dam line is based on these three bloodlines. "I tried to select sires that would improve the conformation and rideability of my mares." Currently Wilhelm Harling is particularly proud of his three-year-old stallion Bonsalino by Bon Coeur, since he is still missing a licensed stallion out of his successful Hannoveraner breeding program.

Wilhelm Harling succeeded several times in reaching the goal of (almost) every breeder to produce powerful and rideable horses for international competitions. Divina Royal actually became an Olympic horse. A remarkable achievement for a rather small breeding farm, which has produced "only" a little more than 70 foals since its existence. All the more remarkable that the horses have made it to the top of the world in both dressage and jumping.

### Stallions in profile

33 stallions were licensed for Hannover for the first time in the past weeks. Linear profiles were made at the licensing.

t the two-day short predisposition tests in Verden, Vechta and Warendorf as well as at the sport tests, young stallions were licensed for Hannover. A Hannoveraner licensing commission was also present at the licensing of the Danish Warmblood Association in Herning. On this occasion, linear profiles of the stallions were created. This is a description of individual characteristics regarding the conformation as well as the basic gaits. For stallions with a jumper pedigree, technique, scope and jumping intelligence are added. For some years now, all mares have been described in a linear way at the mare test and at the mare inspection. For the first time the linear profiles of the stallions are published in

DER HANNOVERANER offering the breeder another highly interesting source of informa-

After the short predisposition tests, which the breeding associations organized as a pilot project as an alternative to the 14-day-tests, breeding Director Ulrich Hahne summed up: "Our impressions of this test are basically positive. We saw stallions in Verden that developed and presented themselves really well on both days. The strength of the horses was enough for the two days. All of them presented themselves positively in accordance with their ages. Jörg Münzner helped with the jumping and Heike Kemmer with the dressage. Our guest riders mostly felt very comfortable on the horses and were able to convey positive impressions to the judging commission. We will compile the experiences from Verden, Vechta, Münster and Warendorf, get feedback from the participants and then decide how the predisposition test should progress in the future."

Quintessential by Q-Sieben/Fiorano from Klosterhof Medingen (breeder: Birgit and Hans-Heinrich Franz, Ratekau) received the best final score of 8,94 in the Niedersachsenhalle.


