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***DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION***

Duplicate certificates can only be issued to horses whose papers were originally issued by the American Hanoverian Society. We cannot issue duplicate passports for German-papered horses. To obtain a duplicate certificate, the owner(s) of the horse must:

1. Complete this form, including the explanation of the loss.
2. The signature of the owner(s) **MUST BE NOTARIZED**.
3. Return the notarized form to the AHS Office along with the appropriate fees. You must be a current AHS member.
4. Submit a minimum of four color photos of the horse clearly showing front, back and both sides, all white markings, brands etc.

Upon receipt of the request for duplicate certificate of registration, we will review the form and process in accordance with the rules and regulations of the AHS.

**DEFINITIONS**

Star	A white mark on the forehead; large, medium, or small
Stripe	A narrow white mark down the face.
Blaze	A broad white mark down the center of the face.
Snip	A small white area on the muzzle or nose.
White Face	A large white area that includes the forehead, face, and often both eyes and nostrils.
Pastern	White markings up to and on the pastern.
Sock	The white area that extends up to or over the fetlock joints.
Heel and Coronet	White markings on the coronet band and/or heel.
Ermine Marks	Black spots on white hairs usually found around the coronet band.
Stocking	A stocking extends up the cannon bone to the knee or hock.
