

The Engler-Friedlander Memorial Trophy

he Engler-Friedlander Memorial Trophy is awarded to the Hanoverian mare that achieves the highest Mare Performance Test score during the annual inspections. The trophy honors the passing in 1998 of former Society President, Hermann Friedlaender, and long-time board member, Dr. Reto Engler. John and Tracy Weyl generously offered to sponsor the trophy.

DANTE'S PRINCESS (DANTE WELTINO-WIE LIEBE/ WOLKENSTEIN II) IS RACKING UP THE ACCOLADES. Not only did she earn a top score in the mare inspection, but she earned the highest score in the mare performance test with a 7.97. In

addition, she was the 2021 USDF Four/Five-Year-Old Materiale Mare Champion with a median score of 83.8, and has competed successfully in the five-year-old young horse classes. Currently she's competing at Third Level with plans for the six-year-old young horse classes this year.

What makes Dante's Princess fun to ride and train is her energy, willingness and gaits. "She has a super hind leg and talent for lateral work, which makes her easy to train," says Marne. However, with all that power, Marne focuses a lot of the work on getting her stronger and more relaxed.

Besides wanting some foals out of her through embryo transfer, Marne hopes she is one of her future Grand Prix

horses—maybe even an international prospect. "She's my heart horse, and one I will enjoy having in the barn for many, many years to come."





The Dr. Hartwig Memorial Trophy

tarted in 2001, the Dr. Hartwig
Memorial Trophy recognizes
the North American-bred threeor four-year-old mare that has the best
combined scores from her studbook
inspection and her Mare Performance Test.

THIS YEAR'S HONOR GOES TO HPMC PENELOPE PITSTOP HF (Pikko Del Cerro HU-Big Girl/Baroncelli), bred and owned by Lisa Thompson Smith. Besides her conformation, gaits and jumping ability, Penelope's temperament is what makes her a winner. According to her trainer, Katie Terrell, Penelope is calm, level-headed and dependable on the ground and under saddle, without being dull.

"I am able to school dressage in the arena or the field," she states. "She also loves cavaletti work and jumping. She doesn't find dressage work boring, even though she loves to jump. Both challenge her and keep her attention."

Penelope has proven to have an extremely honest temperament. As a three year old, Katie described how she could be ridden bareback with only a halter in the field. "One time all the horses around her started galloping past her, and she was completely unphased."

Future plans for Penelope include competing at First and Second Levels with the goal to qualify for regional championships and the US Dressage

The Bari von Buedingen Memorial Trophy

he first of the Society's perpetual trophies, the Bari von Buedingen Memorial Trophy, is awarded in memory of noted breeder Bari von Buedingen who, with her husband, Dr. Richard von Buedingen, developed their broodmare band at Graf Bae Farm into one of the best in the United States. First awarded in 1994, the trophy recognizes the Hanoverian mare earning the highest-score at the annual inspection tour.

SHARING THE TROPHY THIS YEAR WITH AN INSPECTION score of 8.16 is Dante's Princess (Dante Weltino-Wie

Liebe/Wolkenstein II), bred by Jerry Glynne and owned by Marne Martin-Tucker.

Dante's Princess' sire, Dante
Weltino, and her uncle, Desperados
FRH, have proven themselves in the
international dressage arenas, and the
mare line has produced Olympic horses
and approved stallions. And from the
looks of it, Dante's Princess is not
letting her ancestors down.

Obviously Dante Princess has spectacular conformation and movement with a score of 8.16, but Marne says she enjoys her personality too. "She is both a noble and sensitive mare, and I love that."

When she came to Marne, she had a few things to work through such as being quirky about her right ear and not wanting to stand at the mounting block," says Marne. "She is rather a pet, although every once in a while she reminds me she can get excited about things, if she thinks out-of-the-ordinary things are happening. But she trusts me."

Besides competition goals, Marne plans to do embryo transfer with Dante Princess, who earned her elite mare status with mare performance test scores on top of her inspection score.



SHARING THIS PRESTIGIOUS AWARD IS THE HANOVERIAN MARE SARBONNE (Sir Caletto-Filligree S/Freestyle). Sarbonna hails from a very select breeding program, started in 1991 by Barb Gualco of Silverhorne Sporthorse LLC with one very good Thoroughbred mare, Love That Kennedy xx. The bottom side of this pedigree is key to the successful scores achieved by Sarbonne. Love That Kennedy xx participated in the Mare Performance Test (MPT) at the Glenwood site in 1996 and was the top mare in all three sections of the test: conformation, free jumping and under saddle.

Kennedy xx (Kennedy Road xx) had been a winning open jumper on the California A circuit and was bred to a Werther grandson, ES Freestyle (Frappant/Werther). A daughter, Filigree S, was born, raised and participated in the MPT at the Silverhorne site and, again, resulted in a champion test score. Now, the Sir Caletto-Filligree S daughter, Sarbonne, continued the winning way of the dam line by achieving a remarkable score of 8.16. The Caletto I daughters, it has been said, are highly sought after broodmares in Germany and are proving themselves here in the U.S. as excellent crosses for both jumping and dressage prospects with good, uphill frames.

Barb has concluded from her 25-year-long exercise in studying breeding, as well as training and preparation for shows, that her success underscores the relevance of mare inspections and performance testing.

The Benchmark Farm Perpetual Trophy

he Benchmark Farm Award goes each year to the mare with the highest combined jumping score in her MPT.

The Society's North American Jumper Breeding Program (JBP) has strict pedigree and performance requirements. Mares admitted to the program must either meet certain scores in competition or score an overall 8.0, or better (averaged scores for technique and ability) on the jumping portion of the MPT.

IN 2021, LICENSE TO KILL OTJ (Indoctro-Kimberly Landjonker) jumped beyond the minimum requirements for the Benchmark Award by earning an overall score of 9.25 (9.0 technique and 9.5 ability). Licensed to Kill was bred by Christy Bond and is owned by Fox Lair Sport Horses, LLC.

The Premonition BHF Award

he Premonition BHF Perpetual Trophy goes each year to the highest placing Hanoverian in the hunter division. The award is named in honor of Premonition BHF (Pablo-SPS Galaxis/Ganymed), the inaugural winner of this award in 2017.

THIS YEAR'S WINNER is described by his owner, Niki Zarcades, as a sweet overachiever. Bred by Karsten and Bigitte Harrje in Germany, Veyron (Valentino-Enni/Espri) was imported by a hunter trainer as a sales prospect. Niki saw him as a young six-year-old at a county show, where he was cantering around the ring in a two-foot class with the trainer's 10-year-old daughter. Niki remembers he was "chipping and cross-

cantering, but it didn't seem to bother him, and he was a beautiful mover." When Niki tried him later, he ran out at the first jump, a cavaletti! "But the rest of the time, I felt so comfortable with him, and he was the right size for me—he's 16 H and I'm 5'2"—so it was a go."

While Veyron can be a bit sensitive at times, Niki says he's never bucked or gotten silly with her, and he's always respectful of his rider and very careful over jumps. "If he rubs or knocks a rail, the next time he will jump two feet over just to make sure he clears it."

Niki enjoys his positive and outgoing demeanor. "Every day is a new day to him: new sights to see and new horses to talk to." When Niki switched to a new trainer a couple of years ago,

Brooklea Farm Overall Champion Eventing Award

he Brooklea Farm award recognizes the Overall Eventing Horse of the Year. The champion from each of the seven eventing levels-beginner novice through advanced-is assigned a percentage factor that reflects the increasing difficult of the levels. The horse with the most points after the difficulty factor has been added is named the Eventing Horse of the Year.

DANITO, OWNED BY RUTH BLEY, is the 2021 Brooklea Farm Eventing Trophy Winner.

Last year, Danito traveled to the Netherlands to compete as a Nations

Cup team horse at the Military Boekelo where he finished tenth and the team finished second. Expertly piloted by Tamie Smith, they were third after dressage and had two unfortunate rails in show jumping, resulting in the 10th place finish. Danito has been steadily improving in strength and technique in the show jumping ring. If all goes as planned this year, Danito is gearing up for a 5*. Otherwise, this year may provide Danito the opportunity for personal growth.

What makes Danito special is that he shows up for work every day. He's the little orange horse that could and does. He's very unassuming to be around and

his main priority is food. A bomb could go off while you're grazing him and he's not even going to lift his head. Tamie has her work cut out keeping him fit enough to run the upper levels, but they manage to get it done.

The future is hopefully more team events, Europe or national events.

he Greengate Award was established in 2019 by Rachel and Warren Ehrlich of Greengate Farm in Massachusetts to honor the breeder of an American-born horse that is a high score winner at the US Dressage Finals at National and FEI Levels.

SUPERGIRL KS (ES Sinatra Song-MS Nisha KS/ES Nocturno), was bred by Karan and Tom Schwencer of North Carolina. Now owned and ridden by Susan Cotter, Supergirl KS was the 2021 Adult Amateur National Levels winner.

Supergirl spends her days flat out snoozing in the sun with her best friend

Rumor and "drinking black tea from my mug!" says Susan. Supergirl KS also competed at the Dressage at Devon breed show, successfully participated in the MPT, had a top colt (thereby becoming a Hanoverian Premium Mare) and was double champion at the Region 1 GAIG USDF Championships in Training Level Adult Amateur and First Level freestyle. Susan says, "Supergirl and I had an incredible year that still amazes me!"

WRISE UP (ES Wake Up-MS De La Rosa/P.B. De Niro), bred by Leslie Waterman of Tennessee, was the Open National (USEF) Level winner.

Owner/rider Heather Kurtz says, "Wrise Up is one of the sweetest horses I've ever met. He loves to cuddle and be fussed over. He's also an incredibly hard worker, which makes him so fun to ride and train! We plan to compete in the FEI 5-Year-Old classes this year, and hope to make it back to the US Dressage Finals at First Level."

BROOKYLYN GCF (ES Bonheur-EM Greta Garbo/HLP Grand Cru), bred by Sharon Garner, is the FEI Level champion.

My favorite thing about Brooklyn is her work ethic," says Barrett Barksdale. "We are both beginners to the FEI world, but Brooklyn is always ready to learn something new. She is tolerant of my mistakes and her trainability is unparalleled."



The Hilltop Farm, Inc. Young Dressage Horse Award

ponsored by Hilltop Farm, this award is for the highest scoring Hanoverian- or Rhineland-papered young dressage horse competing in the USEF Four-Year-Old classes, FEI Five-Year-Old classes and FEI Six-Year Old Classes at USEF/USDF-licensed dressage shows. A beautiful commissioned painting hangs in the Society office, the frame of which is adorned with the names of the winners.

DON HANNES (Don Romanov-Wanderwelfin/Wanderbursch II) earns the sash for the Hilltop Farm, Inc. Young Dressage horse with a score of 7.98. Don Hannes is owned by Petra Warlimont and Bruce and Maripat Connor and bred by Oliver Wauro.

The Dr. L. Wendell Haymon Memorial Trophy

n July 16, 2020, the equestrian community lost an ardent supporter of Hanoverian dressage breeding, Dr. L. Wendell Haymon, PhD.

Dr. Haymon touched many lives of fellow breeders and dressage enthusiasts. His support of Marydell Farm with his wife, Maryanna Haymon, garnered both national and international respect. One of the primary focus points was the "Born in the USA" programs in dressage. Marydell Farm sponsored high score "Born in the USA" champions at many prestigious CDIs and national shows. Awards included halters, coolers and prize money with 20 percent of the purse going to the breeder and 80 percent to the owner.

In honor of his many contributions, Don and Dee Kapper have generously sponsored this perpetual trophy in Wendell Haymon's name.

IN MEMORY OF WENDELL'S SUPPORT OF "Born in the USA," this new trophy will be for a Society memberowned and Hanoverian-papered stallion, conceived and born in the USA (may be by foreign Hanoverian-approved stallion's frozen semen) that shows at Grand Prix in dressage. The winner will be determined by the highest average score (three score minimum) of those eligible in a given year. A stallion will be eligible if the dam was standing in the United States at time of conception and foals out in the US.

An embroidered cooler for the stallion will be awarded, and the names of the recipients will be placed on the trophy's base. A stallion may only receive the trophy two times with the same rider.

The perpetual trophy is a bronze by artist, Tammy Tappan of Equine Instincts, and is of a stallion piaffing. Standing 18 inches tall, 18 inches long and 9 inches wide, weighing approximately 40 pounds, the trophy bears the name of Marydell Farm's flagship stallion, Don Principe. The names of the recipients will be placed on a based made from the white oak of a 200-year-old tree from Marydell Farm.

While standing in the US, Don Principe was the sire of Doctor Wendell MF (Don Principe/Sandro Hit). "Doc" has gone on to be an international competitor with his adult amateur owner/rider, winning the "Russia Cup" for Grand Prix, and being selected for the Tokyo Olympics. He is currently ranked 108th in the world at Grand Prix. If Doctor Wendell MF was in the US, he would be the initial recipient of the Dr. L. Wendell Haymon Memorial.

2021 Gold Medal Foals

This Gold Medal program is offered by Hannoveraner International, the organization for Hanoverian societies outside of Germany. Foals with a dressage pedigree are judged on type, conformation, walk and trot and must receive a score of 8.0 or higher. Jumping-pedigree foals are judged on type, conformation and basic gaits and need to score 7.5 or higher. This is not a foal competition, nor is it automatically awarded to the top foal at the inspection. Instead, judges will internally score foals at the inspection to determine the top dressage and jumping foals but those scores will not be recorded.






