An anniversary at the right time

This is the second annual report, whose content is clearly influenced by the Corona pandemic. It should be noted that, on one hand, Corona has (temporarily) slowed down developments and, on the other hand, it accelerated others.

For a whole year it was clearly audible, and highly visible because of the temporarily adapted logo of the association: The 100th anniversary of the Hannoveraner Verband. Many members seized this opportunity to start again after a social break of about two years. Thus, a total of good 4,000 Hannoveraner fans came to meet up at various festivities organized by horse breeding clubs, district associations and the Verband placing the horse and the social aspect in the centre. Once again, thanks are due to all guests, organizers and hosts; they created a special atmosphere during difficult times, of which the community of the Hannoveraner Verband can be proud. During the anniversary year, some projects were finalized which are now available to the breeders. An essential feature marking the modernness of the Hannoveraner Verband is the conversion of the highly appreciated "Hannoveraner Yearbook Stallions" from a book to a digital format. There are advantages to this new offer as it is freely available to all breeders, it is daily updated, and it includes extended data. After many years of the paid

reference book, the "Jahrbuch Hengste digital" ("Stallion Book digital") is now available exclusively as an online version on www.hannoveraner.com. It is intended to offer support with breeding decisions.

A change in the way knowledge is imparted to breeders was implemented relatively ad hoc two years ago when Verden's horse seminars could no longer take place in their familiar face-to-face form. After the trial year 2021, an extensive range of web seminars in online format started in 2022. 19 events recorded a total of 391 participants, who were advised and exchanged experiences with the speakers from the team of the Hannoveraner Verband. For 2023, the range of web seminars has been expanded again. In the spirit of sustainability, the Hannoveraner Verband decided to become part of the "International Association for Future Horse Breeding", IAFH for short. The purpose of the IAFH is the development of the genomic selection in horses. Over the past six years, preliminary work has already been done by other

German horse breed associations; now everyone benefits from the already gained know-how. In addition, the security improved because of the large number of horses, which the Hannoveraner Verband contributed. The genomic selection has not yet been finalized for application, but together with the larger German horse breed associations, the Hannoveraner Verband will promote its implementation. At the moment, it is still unclear onto which areas of horse breeding it will actually have an influence – the breeding objective health is favored. The introduction of the health premium Vet+ for mares, which is awarded when mares meet the health standards for approved stallions, should also be seen in this context. To focus on the breeding of lasting, healthy horses must be the common goal of breeders and the Hannoveraner Verband.

As usual, the key figures in the breeding sector paint a mixed picture. It is regrettable that the number of members and the total number of registered mares continues declining. The effect that the Verband gradually loses very long-standing members who have not been actively breeding for some time, continues. Fortunately, the number of registered foals has climbed above the 7,000 mark for the first time in five years. Just under half of these foals were registered from 60 stallions of whom 30 plus foals were presented last year. Considering that foals were registered by a total of 816 different stallions, these stallions listed in the chart have a strong influence on the Hannoveraner breed. From the top 10 of these stallions, information about the riding qualities of the offspring is only available from every second one. This shows that Hannoveraner breeders still focus predominantly on what happens on the foal market. This year, we encountered a situation of a special nature. It was a small collection of foals, which were born as part of the project "The Experi-

ment". These foals were by special Hannoveraner stallions of the past such as Werther, Don Juan, Espri and others. After viewing the foals last year, this project, which was launched in 2021, can be called a success; there will be a new edition this year. Due to the double pre-disposition of some of the offered stallions, "the experiment" will be extended to dressage mares.

If one takes the number of coverings as a preview of the foal crop in 2023, a further increase in foal numbers cannot be expected in the coming year. However, this number has not always proven to be a reliable indicator in the past and will be an incentive for promoting the registration of foals with the Hannoveraner Verband. The number of new registrations is at last year's level, although there was an additional Corona backlog to be dealt with in 2021. This area also is at a five-year high. Its development, however, cannot be transferred to broodmare tests and mare shows. There, the numbers continued to decline, which calls for revising this system. The number of presented mares no longer justifies the effort that is involved in some areas. Basically, the events at the district and club level returned back to normal for the most part last summer after the Corona restrictions of the previous year. Regarding the mare performance tests, there already are first modifications in form of the Hannoveraner sport tests for dressage, jumping and eventing, which are currently also being run with great effort. In the coming years, it will be decided whether these can become established. For the mare shows, extensions including free running and a pavement test are planned. With installing these, the selection of mares will be improved. Furthermore, for the first time in the history of the Hannoveraner Verband, mares from other breeding areas can be presented for premium awards. The adoption of premiums from other associations was also extended to

premiums that may not exist in this form at the Hannoveraner Verband. As every year, the show season culminated in the Herwart von der Decken-Show, which was a fixed event for many people interested in breeding at the beginning of August and was the prelude to the Hannoveraner Championships. The quality of the young mares was convincing and the Herwart von der Decken-Show celebrated a real novelty with the victory of Hann. Pr.A. Olympia by Ogano/Diacontinus (breeder: Enrico Messelis, Kefferhausen). For the first time in the history of this show a daughter of a former champion mare took the lead.

There have always been structural changes and changes in the number of horses and members. In full awareness of this, the Hannoveraner Verband would like to continue being involved in the regions, ensuring the so important solidarity with the help of the valuable voluntary work of the local horse breeding clubs and promoting the liaison with breeders on the regional level. This is one of the reasons why the board, all other committees and the main office dealt with the strategy of the Hannoveraner Verband over the course of the year. We cannot report on all the results yet; often the course and further procedures were discussed, recommended, partly discarded and then reintro-

duced. Good will, professionalism and a lot of conviction for the cause characterized this work in the committees. Thanks are due to all committee members for their commitment on all levels. In the spring of 2023, the strategy proposals will be presented and discussed at district assemblies and then finalized at the meeting of the delegates in April. All areas of the Hannoveraner Verband will be touched upon: Breeding, marketing, breeder support, event and service offers at the Verden location, marketing etc.. An important principle was to simplify the breeding regulations, to check capacities in the organization of events and to integrate new members into the horse breeding club- and association system in a structured way.

The increasing discipline-related specialization in the breeding of riding horses is currently taken into account with different requirement profiles in the evaluation of dressage and show jumping horses. A logical consequence of this development is recognizable in the fact that dressage and show jumping horses have genetically grown apart more and more. The question arises whether further steps towards specialization must follow. In the breeding of show jumpers, the Hannoveraner Breeding Program for show jumping has been further developed and a multi-level system has

been introduced. At the entry level, almost all jumping mares are considered. A division of the population is thus already indicated. The technical implementation of the innovations in the Hannoveraner Breeding Program for show jumping required a great deal of effort and ultimately took a little longer than expected, but is now nearing completion. For the breeders of event horses, there were two innovations. For the first time, a Hannoveraner sport test for eventing was held in Harbansen and Rüssel; it was an aptitude test with cross-country obstacles. The mares that were presented there, could additionally apply for the Hannoveraner premium award. On the first weekend in March, the issue of eventing was also a focus of interest at the Niedersachsenhalle. A clinic, an indoor event and a discussion on the question of the necessity of using Thoroughbred blood in the breeding of event horses made up a worthwhile event. Repeats of both are planned; in addition, the implementation of a training concept for talented event horses is also on the agenda.

The annual event calendar showed well-known continuity with regard to the selection of champions. On different occasions, the Hannoveraner champions of high quality were selected in the disciplines jumping, dressage and eventing in various age groups. The show jumpers were again offered the indoor event "Jumping Horse-Masters", which was held as a second lighthouse event in conjunction with the stallion licensing for show jumpers. The terrain in Verden offers a suitable setting for many types of equestrian sport events, so that the German Youth Championships in Dressage and Show Jumping were held there for the first time.

The final for four-year old stallions in Warendorf turned into a real triumphal procession. With San

to Alati by Secret/Belissimo M (breeder: Lena-Marie and Kerstin Klose, Burgwedel), Segantini by Secret/Fidermark (breeder: Dr. Christine Feichtinger, Vaduz/LIE) and My Milano by Millennium/De Niro (breeder: Johann von der Decken, Krummendich), Hannoveraner stallions won gold, silver and bronze. A total of twelve medals were awarded to horses with the Hannoveraner hip brand, and even if these seem to be distributed somewhat unevenly to the disadvantage of the show jumpers, the horses, which were shown in Warendorf, give hope for all disciplines from the viewpoint of the Hannoveraner Verband. In addition to Verband's and Bundeschampionat, Hannoveraner

and Rhineland horses were able to hold their own worldwide. Duke of Britain FRH by Dimaggio/Rubinstein (breeder: Sarah and Tony Pidgley, Windsor/GBR) with Frederic Wandres and Franziskus FRH by Fidertanz/Alabaster (breeder: Elisabeth Albers, Löningen) ridden by Ingrid Klimke represented Germany at the World Championships in Herning/DEN. The WBFSH ranking selected the Count Grannus/Sherlock Holmes-son Count in Me (breeder: Friedrich Lüßmann, Neustadt; owner: Conor Swail, IRE) as the third most successful show jumper in the world for the 2021/22 season. And for the second time, Dr. Hilmer Meyer-Kulenkampff from Behlmer was rewarded as the breeder of the best event horse, fischerChipmunk FRH. Michael Jung not only won the prestigious five-star competition in Lexington/USA with the now 15-year-old bay, but also became team world champion in Pratoni del Vivaro/ITA.

The society's perception of the actions taken regarding horses in general is also reflected in the discussion about the timing of the licensing. This has not only come under criticism outside the breeding community. At the licensing of the jumping stallions, a three-year-old stallion was part of the collection for the second time in a row. As in the previous year, this stallion was able to convince the licensing committee and customers alike. The Hannoveraner Verband is therefore already offering its breeders who consider the licensing at two-and-a-half years of age to be too ear-

ly, an alternative. This path too can successfully be taken. The Hannoveraner Verband and its breeders must also question themselves on this issue and accept this discussion. The Verband supports maintaining the licensing for two-and-a-half year old stallions. It faces the discussion with the authorities and strives for a consensus in cooperation with them. But the industry must be willing to make changes in the preparation and in the presentation of young stallions and recognize that a need for change exists. The fact that the dressage stallions no longer have to jump at the licensing met with a mixed response from the breeding community. However, this measure can also be viewed in the context of trying to reduce the stress on young horses at the licensing. In terms of quantity and quality, the licensing events, which were once again held separately, remained at last year's level with a somewhat broader top.

New and existing projects need to be repeatedly presented to the members in order to push on ahead their use and implementation. Hence the members' magazine DER HANNOVERANER continues to have its right to exist and received corresponding feedback in the members' survey. The members' online-use of media continues to show a comparatively rising trend. For example, the number of Facebook followers increased to 69,562 (2021: 68,567) with which Hannover's account reached 7,766,516 (2021: 6,859,116) with all its posts. The Instagram statistics show

the following: 40,900 followers (2021: 34,803), a range of 605,235 (2021: 2,816,133). Next to this is the number of views on Hannover's homepage with around 205,056 users (2021: 269,220). Decreases are to be explained by the shift in user media behavior; furthermore, the auction events are almost completely presented via an independent online auction website (300,127 users).

Within the overall industry, horse sales in 2022 continued to benefit from a shortage of horses coupled with the important foreign business. Nevertheless, compared to previous years, a downturn is visible and is understandable in view of the global economic and financial changes in 2022. Different auctions were affected very differently; they can be divided into segments. Stable were the number of and participation in foal auctions overall with slightly reduced acceptance numbers (2022: 303 foals, 2021: 324 foals). Throughout the entire period, those interested in foals were more reserved than in the two previous years (turnover 2022: 2,945,730 Euros, 2021: 3,434,250 Euros). The riding horse auctions in January, April, July and November can be described as stable. Their total turnover reached 5,088,000 Euros (2021: 4,768,000 Euros); 217 horses were sold (2021: 217). The elite riding horse auction reflected a significant deviation to last year's result

(2022 turnover: Euro 2,375,500, 2021: Euro 3,234,500). In hindsight, the overall quality in 2022 did not come close to the overall horse quality in 2021. The results of the stallion sales dressage recorded a decline of the same magnitude (sales 2022: 3,005,000 Euros, 2021: 4,103,000 Euros) and entails considerations about the admission strategy. At the end of the year, the stallion sales jumping was pleasing, maintaining last year's good level (turnover 2022: 1,039,000 Euros, 2021: 1,132,000 Euros). Overall, the sales volume is reduced by a good 2.5 million Euros and thus has a noticeable negative influence on the annual result of the Hannoveraner Verband.

After another year of the by now familiar online auction activity, a summary must also be drawn of the so-called OnLive-auction procedure (a hybrid auction). In 2021, they still appeared to be a driving force for the stallion sales. This could not be confirmed in 2022. Thus, the auction mix of live and online auctions will be reconsidered for 2023. All the more remarkable is the crowd puller "Gala Evening" on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the Hannoveraner Verband, which sold out early. The "Treffpunkt Verden" ("Meeting Place Verden) was outstanding on the eve of the elite auction; Hannoveraner breeders from all over Germany filled the stands. ■

Calanda was among the best in each of her three classes at the CSI5*-W in London/GBR. In her first class, the Calido/Chasseur/Glockenklang-daughter (line of Segalta; breeder: Heinz Lorenz, Regesbostel) placed ninth with Marcus Ehning in the jumping class for the rankings (1.50 metres). Afterwards, she did not get a single penalty point, won "The Snowflake Stakes" (1.50 metres) and finished third in Sunday's main jumping competition (1.50 metres).

They continued on the "Tour de Suisse" to Basel/SUI. In the St. Jakobs-arena, they celebrated a fifth placing in the championships (1.55 metres).

Contendros

Codex

The Contendros/Espri/Sandro-son Codex (line of Corona; breeder: ZG Luttmann, Klein Heins) has turned his back on Germany's winters. In Florida, the ten-year-old and his rider Richard Vogel finished eighth in the main jumping competition (1.50 metres) on the final day of the CSI3* in Wellington/USA.

Conlouba

One of the top finishers at the CSI4*-W in Abu Dhabi/UAE on the first weekend in January was the Contendros/Baloubet du Rouet/Carthago-son Conlouba (line of Gralsgöttin; breeder: Stud Lewitz, Mühlen). With Abdurakhmon Abdullaev from the Republic of Uzbekistan, the eleven-year-old finished third in a 1.45 meter-class.

Cordobes

Coenig (Rhld.)

At the CSI4* in Riyadh/KSA, Coenig by Cordobes/Baloubet du Rouet/Pit (line of Pia; breeder: Gerd and Sylvia Koenen, Viersen) and Abdullah Humaid Al Muhairi won a jumping competition against the clock by a lead of over five seconds. The journey continued to the CSI3*-W in Al-Ain/UAE, 1,000 kilometres to the east, where Coenig made it onto the podium with a third placing in a class with jump-off for the victory.

Cornet's Balou

Crack Balou

At the Persian Gulf, the Cornet's Balou/Chacco-Blue/Carthago-son Crack Balou (line of Lunda; breeder: Stud Lewitz, Mühlen) and Emanuele Gaudiano finished the Grand Prix (1.55 metres) at the CSI4*-W in Riyadh/KSA on an excellent third place without incurring a single jumping fault. Only two other pairs managed this feat. One week later, the show had one more star and Crack Balou celebrated a sixth placing in the Grand Prix (1.60 metres) after finishing fourth in the World Cup-jumping competition (1.55 metres). Next destination: The CSI5*-W in Mechelen/BEL, where Crack Balou won the jumping competition of the "Open Sires of the World".

successful in Riyadh, Mike Wazowski competed in California. At the CSI5* in Thermal/USA, he finished the main jumping competition (1.50 metres) on Friday in fourth place with Nicolas Pizarro.

Cornet Obolensky

Cornet's Iberio

In London/GBR, Cornet Obolensky/Iberio/Acorado (line of Steingilde; breeder: Heinrich Ramsbrock, Menslage) and Denis Lynch flew into a brilliant sixth place in the World Cup-show jumping competition (1.60 metres). Next stop: The CSI5*-W in Basel/SUI. In the St. Jakobs-arena, the Irish/Hanoverian combination won silver in a jumping competition against the clock. Two days later, they finished eighth in the speed class (1.50 metres).

Count Grannus

Count Me In

The Count Grannus/Sherlock Holmes/Mahonson Count Me In (line of Maritim; breeder: Friedrich Lüßmann, Neustadt) is back in Europe. At the CSI5* in Geneva/SUI, the powerful dark bay won the main jumping competition (1.50 metres) on Friday with Conor Swail. He continued his journey across the channel to London. At the World Cup-competition in the "Exhibition Centre London", which is called ExCel. for short, the pair finished second in "The Champagne-Taittinger Ivy Stakes" (1.50 metres).

PB Portofino by Lord Pezi and Karin Martinsen finished eighth in the Frankfurt Grand Prix and won the Exloo Grand Prix.

After a pasture accident, **Büttner's Minimax** had to be put down. The 13-year-old Cornado/Antaeus-son, bred by Wilhelm Harling in Sottrum was one of Janne-Friederike Meyer-Zimmermann's top jumpers. Only in August last year, they had won the Grand Prix of Münster and shortly thereafter placed third in the Grand Prix of Helsinki/FIN. "You were my beloved unicorn, my friend, my superstar, and my hero. You were the boss in the stables and a juggernaut at competitions. You loved the big stage. No obstacle was too high for you, no ditch too wide and no audience too loud," the rider shared on the internet. Only a few days before, she had secured the full brother of Büttner's Minimax at Verden's licensing.

In Great Britain, Alice Ruth Oppenheimer lost her Grand Prix horse. While running free in the indoor arena, her homebred **Headmore Dirubino** by Dimaggio/Rubinstein suffered an irreparable fracture of the fetlock joint.

At the same time, her sister Sonata MF, who is two years younger, was highly successful on the Small Tour.

Sonata MF

While her right-hand sister Serenade MF caused a sensation in the World Cup-freestyle, the Sir Donnerhall/Don Principe/Rotspon-daughter Sonata MF (line of Firuza; breeder: Maryanna Haymon, Columbus/USA) trotted into her first international top placing at the CDI1* in Wellington/USA. Amanda Perkowski rode the 2015-born bay into third position in the Prix St. Georges.

Stalypso
Lord Django

With Lord Django, a descendant of the show jumping sire Stalypso reached the World Cup-level in the dressage ring. Lord Django by Stalypso/Londonderry/Wanderkönig (line of Dichterschloss; breeder: Hermann Heeren, Westoverledingen) finished third in the Grand Prix with Caroline Darcourt at the CDI-W in Wellington (Stadium)/USA. The 13-year-old had already taken the same placement in the Grand Prix.

Vitalis
Vita di Lusso (Rhld.)

The "Equestrian Christmas Party" was celebrated in the festively decorated indoor arena in Mechelen/BEL. The Vitalis/Weltano/Archipel-son Vita di Lusso (line of Magadis; breeder: Yeguada De Ymas, Madrid/Spain) danced to victory in the Prix St. Georges with Dinja van Liere. In the Inter-freestyle, the bay stallion, born in 2015, won silver. ■

She could hardly believe it herself: At her first start in the final of the Nürnberger Burg-Pokal, Andrina Suter celebrated a double victory. The Swiss rider, who had already competed at the European Championships as a young rider five times, won the prestigious competition with her Westphalian-registered Belissimo M/Dresemann-son Briatore NRW and finished second aboard Del Curto by Dimaggio/Wolkentanz II (breeder: Hendrik Moss, Neuenhaus). With this result, she was not only the star in the festive indoor arena, but also won the prize for style. Three years

ago, Andrina Suter won dressage horse tests with the liver chestnut, and in July 2022, they participated in the Small Tour at the CHIO Aachen. At the final of the Burg-Pokal, the overall impression of the large gelding and his rider was particularly convincing. "That is what we want to see: Relaxed horses with great movements," Christoph Hess raved. 76.097 percent was a number, which only Del Curto's stable mate Briatore was able to surpass in the end with his score of 77.146. The Wynton/Latimer-son Wynton's Son (breeder: Thorsten Hogrefe, Stöcken), another outstanding Hannoveraner, followed closely behind winning the bronze medal. Thomas Wagner presented the brown stallion masterfully. "He has the looks and the beak, as they say," was the comment.

Elitist by Escolar/De Niro (breeder: Ella Katzorke, Essen), who was the top seller at the 134th elite auction in Verden and changed into the proven hands of Family Schmitz-Heinen, was the best horse from the Rhineland. At the auction, he already impressed with his large frame, his charisma, outstanding movement and great talent. In Frankfurt, he finished sixth with Juliane Brunkhorst. Three horse-rider combinations participated in the freestyle for the winning prize. Wynton's Son and Thomas Wagner took the lead with a convincing performance, Del Curto and Andrina followed in third place.

The next level on the success ladder for young dressage horses is the coveted Louisdor-Prize. In the Grand Prix for young dressage horses, Hann.Pr. A. Amanyara M by Ampere/Savignon (breeder: Hans-Jügen Meyer, Nottuln) placed third with Dr. Svenja Kämper-Meyer. The security in all the exercises and

her 'listening-to-the-rider' are the result of trust, which was built over time," said Dr. Dietrich Plewa. A Quaterhall/Lanthan-son (breeder: Hans-Jürgen and Andrea Dankers, Heeslingen) finished fifth with Austria's Christian Reisch. Frederic Wandres rode Harrods by Hochadel/Rotspon (breeder: Bernhard and Nadine Wenhaus, Isterburg) into 7th position. They had entered the competition with a second placing in the qualification, but unfortunately experienced a bad day. ■

Edward produced the world's best jumper

An analysis of the interactions of the FN breeding value estimations for young horse classes and for highest achieved class (HEK) with each other and with the WBFSH-rankings of stallions provides interesting conclusions about the development of breeding sport horses.

From a Hannoveraner point of view, the results of the breeding value estimation of the German Equestrian Federation (FN) "young horse tests jumping" are outstanding: Ten of the eleven highest estimated stallions of this national breeding value estimation carry the Hannoveraner foal brand. With these results in the breeding value estimation HEK and especially in the stallion rankings of the WBFSH, one thing becomes very clear: Stakkato is the stallion that has had the strongest influence on the breeding of Hannoveraner show jumpers in the past years. He himself has the second highest breeding value in this group; with Qualito, Stanley, Stakkato Gold, Sampres, Perigueux and Chacco Chacco, another six stallions have Stakkato as their sire or on their dam's side.

Qualito remains number 1

It is highly interesting to see how the offspring of the younger stallions in this group developed. The Quaid/Salito-son Qualito, born in 2011 and bred by Helmut Habermann in Hänigsen, was a state stud stallion in Celle out of the outstanding mare line of Norm, but died in 2018. This is a great loss, as he now is the highest rated jumper stallion in this group for the second time. The oldest offspring are just seven years old and their developments reflect a clearly positive trend. Already five offspring have successes at the advanced (S)-level. The most successful is probably Quintana (breeder: Hans Henning von der Decken, Stade) out of an Embassy-daughter. With Stephi Boer, she placed in the S**^{*}-final of the Bundeschampionat in 2022.

Qualito's sire Quaid by Quidam's Rubin (breeder: Friedhelm Vehlber, Espelkamp), who was owned by the Czech Hannoveraner stud Staj Mustang, has already made a name for himself as a producer of

horses of international quality, which successfully compete up to 1.60 meters. He has an HEK-breeding value of 135 and thus belongs to the best ten percent of this breeding value estimation. His breeding value is also confirmed by his WBFSH-ranking, where he ranks among the top 100 worldwide with a 68th placing. 18 offspring of Quaid have already collected international ranking points, exclusively Hannoveraner!

But back to the breeding value estimation for "young horse classes". In this group, Celle's state stud stallion Grey Top by Graf Top/Singular Joter (breeder: Emiliano Lonzi, Fauglia-Pisa/ITA) is always in the limelight as the hopeful for continuing the G-line; furthermore, the development of Chacco Chacco's heredity is also very interesting. The oldest offspring of Grey Top are ten years of age. In the USA, Taylor Land already competes Grey Top's son Get Go (dam's sire: World Diamond; breeder: ZG Herbot and Nesemann, Stöckse) in 1.60 metre-jumping competitions. Grey Top's licensed son Grey Chester (dam's sire: Picard; breeder: Cornelia Peters, Südbrookmerland) already placed internationally up to 1.55 metres with Harm Lahde. The internet site Horsetelex lists eight more Grey Top-descendants that already reached jumping classes up to 1.50 metres. A development that can be considered a positive trend.

Chacco Chacco was born in the same year as Grey Top. His ten-year-old son Gamin van't Naastveldhof, bred in Belgium out of a mare by Toulon, is sensational. With the Swiss rider Edouard Schmitz, he won the Grand Prix of Dublin in August of 2022 and, with that success, arrived at the top of the world. As a son of Chacco Blue and out of a dam by Stakkato/Grannus/Furioso II, the number one in



the WBFSH stallion rankings Chacco Chacco has an outstanding pedigree. He was bred by Klaus Jürgens in Sehnde, the breeder of Diacontinus, who sold him to Stud Tannenhof on Verden's stallion sales in 2009. Chacco Chacco himself has sporting successes up to 1.60 metres. In the meantime, he has moved from Stud Tannenhof to Brandenburg's Main and State Stud Neustadt/Dosse and has earned the interest of the breeders of Hannoveraner show jumpers. With an HEK-breeding value of 136, he is in the top ten percent of the most highly valued stallions in this category.

The top of the HEK breeding value estimation of the German Equestrian Federation is dominated by stallions that predominantly breed or bred in the Netherlands, Belgium or France. The offspring of such stallions, which are included in the breeding value estimation, are not necessarily representatives of the wide range of their heredity. For example, Kashmir van het Schuttershof has the second highest breeding value. The German Equestrian Federation lists him as the sire of 37 sport horses that are included in the HEK breeding value estimation. On Horsetelex, on the other hand, 1,346 adult offspring of him are listed, many of which have show successes. With such a strong pre-selection of horses, one has to expect an overestimation of breeding values. Most of his offspring are out of Belgian or French breeding programs; many of them come to Germany from neighboring countries only to compete in top level shows. The inclusion of such horses in the national German breeding value estimation brings questionable results. What is missing is the broad spectrum of offspring – horses that are only presented at the lower levels of competitions, as it is the case with show jumpers, which were born in Germany. This is a systematic effect of the breeding value estimation that urgently needs in-depth investigation. Breeding and sport have become very international. An international breeding value estimation – which is already being discussed – would therefore also make sense.

The Hannoveraner stallion with the highest HEK breeding value once again is Stakkato's son Stakkato Gold (breeder: Arend Kamphorst, Prieros) with a breeding value of 159. This is also a good transition to the WBFSH stallion-ranking. Because he is also the highest ranked Hannoveraner stallion in this ranking with place number 27. Compared to the previous year, when he was ranked 62nd, he has made a huge leap forward, which is due to the fact that some of his offspring are now established among the world's best competitors. These include the two Oldenburg horses Stargold, who Marcus Ehning successfully rode in the World

Championships in Herring/DEN, and Solid Gold Z, with whom Christian Ahlmann is internationally successful. Nine-year-old Hannoveraner Starissa (dam's sire: Quidam's Rubin; breeder: Albert Sprehe, Essen), who impressed with excellent rounds at the highest level with rider Mario Stevens, certainly is one of the most exciting younger German show jumpers.

Edward remains interesting

Celle's state stud stallion Edward by Embassy/Fabiano (breeder: Hans-Heinrich Dittmer, Radbruch), who holds the 59th position in the WBFSH stallion-ranking, landed an unbelievable hit with his purely Hannoveraner bred son King Edward. With Henrik von Eckermann, the team Olympic champion from Tokyo became double world champion in Herring/DEN. Subsequently his breeder Wim Impens now heads on the WBFSH world-ranking for breeders of show jumpers. Was this pure coincidence in the roulette of breeding horses? Probably not, because there are indications that this success is also genetically secured on the sire's side. At the age of three, Edward had completed an outstanding stal-

lion performance test over 300 days and belonged to the top group in dressage (142.93 points) as well as in jumping (120.72 points). As a dressage horse, he was then further trained and successfully brought into the sport. This may have led to the fact that the breeders of show jumpers did not really have their eyes on him and instead that he was much sought after by breeders of dressage horses. Breeding dressage mares to jumping stallions resulted in successful show jumpers. Examples are El Zorro (up to 1.50 metres) out of a Wolkentanzdam (breeder: Hoswitha Buchner, Bad Harzburg) and Ernie (up to 1.55 metres) out of a Wolkenstein II-dam (breeder: Martin Klemm, Beverstedt); both collected world ranking-points. In New Zealand, the Hannoveraner breeder Judith Matthews used him. Her mare Grandessa MH by Gymnastik Star/Graf Landau produced Enya MH, who is only ten years old and has already competed up to 1.60 metres. Edward's dam St.Pr.St. Fabienne by Fabriano has already produced two S-successful show jumpers; one of them is a right brother of Edward. The second dam St.Pr.St. Schneekönigin by Singular Joter has also delivered several successful show jumpers. Two of them are internationally successful: Taylormade Cash is King by Cassini II up to 1.60 metres and Chablis del Chirone by Clinton II up to 1.50 metres; both were bred in Italy by Bruna de Paolis. Behind them follow daughters of the performance stallions Servus and Gotthard, who also sired S-successful show jumpers. If you take a close look at the statistics of the mare line of Neapaza, you see that it is clearly influenced by jumper blood. So, to our breeders of Hannoveraner jumpers: Edward is a stallion who deserves to be trusted – but with the notice that mares bred to him must test negative for WFFS. By the way, with respect to technique, willingness to perform and quality, King Edward reminded us with his outstanding performances in Tokyo and Herning of Hugo Simon's legendary show jumper E.T. FRH, a son of Espri, the third sire of Edward.

In the WBFSH ranking, seven Hannoveraner stallions made it into the top 100. You find Stakkato there as well as his sons Stakkato Gold and Ucato, as well as Perigueux, in whose pedigree Stakkato appears as his dam's sire. Former state stud stallion Count Grannus by Contendro/Graf Grannus (breeder: Heinrich Ramsbrock, Menslage), who was sold to Spruce Meadows in Canada, is ranked 88th. He owes his ranking to his son Count Me In out of a dam by Sherlock Holmes, who matured into an absolute world-class horse with the Irishman Conor Swail. This success earned his breeder Friedrich Lüßmann from Neustadt third place in the WBFSH world-ranking for breeders of show jumpers.

The mentioned examples prove that Hannoveraner show jumping-genetics are competitive. Hannoveraner breeders of show jumpers have the opportunity to use top international stallions – an opportunity that is used intensively and successfully. To reach the top of the WBFSH stallion-ranking, it is necessary that as many offspring of a stallion as possible enter international competitions. Therefore it is important that Hannoveraner breeders of show jumpers sufficiently consider Hannoveraner stallions. A desirable goal in the use of international stallions is establishing new stallion lines. A good example that this can succeed is the sought-after and proven Diacontinus, who goes back to Diamant de Semilly via his sire Diarado, who is found at the top of the world ranking.

Young dressage stallions: Secret is top

The stallions Revolution, Asgards Ibiza and Fürst Fabrice are new in the breeding value estimation of young horse competitions and made it into the top ten right away. They displaced the stallions Zoom and Morricone. Secret by Sezuan/St.Moritz has worked his way up within the top ten-group and is now number one. He is one of the most sought-after stallions in Germany and is well on his way to positively influence the breeding of Hannoveraner dressage horses. The high dressage breeding value of 164 already is very highly secured by 96 percent. The reason: The breeding value is based on the evaluation of 244 offspring. 112 of them competed in breed classes (broodmare tests, stallion tests) and 162 in young horse-classes, predominantly in young horse dressage classes. When Secret, born in 2014, first appeared as a stallion in 2017, he was not without controversy due to existing weaknesses in his foundation. As a matter of fact, as a breeder you have to take this into account in terms of the horse's stability. The Hannoveraner breeding value estimation reflects a clearly below-average breeding value for fore limbs with 72 and for hind limbs with 84; the breeding value for correctness, on the other hand, is surprisingly high with a value of 122. The Hannoveraner breeding value estimation broodmare test/auction is based on the evaluation of 45 offspring. There the strengths are clearly visible. An outstanding breeding value for the canter of 161 and also the breeding value for rideability with 138 is far above average. In addition, there are outstanding results of his offspring in stallion performance tests (e. g. Segantini) and at the Bundeschampionat (e.g. San to Alati). 13 sons have already been licensed by the Hannoveraner Verband. At the age of three, he was the Vice-Bundeschampion in the division for riding horses; at the age of five, he was the vice world champion in the division for young dressage horses, and, in 2020, he was the Bundeschampion

in dressage. Revolution by Rocky Lee/Rouletto was the world champion of young dressage horses in 2018 and the vice world champion in 2019. Although he passes on to his offspring a large frame and his size, as foals, they are often rather inconspicuous, but then develop very positively under the rider. The very good breeding value of 161 for young horse tests is based on the evaluations of 52 horses – 27 in breed classes and 36 in classes for young horses. All three basic gaits and the rideability are rated equally high with breeding values between 145 and 152, more than two standard deviations above the average.

Fürst Fabrice by Fürstenball/Sandro Hit, the champion stallion of the 2016 licensing in Oldenburg and licensed for the Hannoveraner Verband, appears with his first FN breeding values, which, however, are not yet highly secured with only three offspring in breeding classes and four in young horse-classes. A positive hereditary tendency is indicated. The Hannoveraner son Fabulous Fred (breeder: Hans-Ludwig Beilken, Bremen) out of a dam by De Niro also contributes to this positive hereditary tendency with a second and a third placing in two tests for young dressage horses with rider Antonia Pietsch.

The KWPN stallion Asgard's Ibiza by Desperado/Jazz, who was well received by Hannoveraner breeders, presented his first crop in 2017. He confirmed his high breeding value of 156 from the previous year and thus climbed up into the group of the top ten. The number of offspring whose successes are included in the breeding value estimation has naturally increased; the FN breeding value is thus even better secured with the increased security of 94 percent. There is a clear improvement visible in the Hannoveraner breeding value estimation. The breeding value for dressage climbed from 117 to 122. Looking at the individual breeding values, the breeding value for rideability at 134 is most convincing. Almost half (17) of his Hannoveraner and Rhineland daughters (36 in total) have been awarded premiums, six of his sons are already registered in the Hannoveraner stallion book I. Ibiza Dream, Iron and In my Mind have already convinced with their first offsprings. All in all, a good balance. It is definitely conceivable that the offspring will grow into completing higher tasks. Asgard's Ibiza, the finalist of the 2018 World Championships for Young Dressage Horses is now nine years old and competed in six advanced (S-) level dressage competitions in 2022 with Markus Gribbe and already won four of them.

Are older stallions from abroad overrated? The group of the top ten of the HEK breeding value

estimation shows once again how stable the breeding values are. All top ten stallions of 2021 are also the top ten stallions of 2022 – even if there are small shifts in rank within the group. Jazz leads the group of dressage stallions. He also was a stal-

lion whose breeding focus was in a neighboring country, in this case the Netherlands, where he influenced the breeding of dressage horses like no other. Hence his breeding value is more than one standard deviation higher than that of the second ranked Breitling W. Presumably, the same effect of preselection exists that was already mentioned for the show jumping stallions. 159 Jazz' offspring are included in the breeding value estimation "Highest Achieved Class". However, only just under 40 German offspring with competition results are registered with the FN. The majority of the horses that were taken into account were therefore probably registered by the KWPN and included in the breeding value estimation due to international successes.

For the first time, Vitalis by Vivaldi joined the three stallions in tenth place with a breeding value of 188. He is one of the younger stallions who more than hint at a generational change in the WBFSH ranking of dressage stallions in 2022. In this list, he is ranked 11th. It is remarkable that he was able to achieve this as a 15-year-old stallion with his first sons and daughters in Westphalia. His just ten-year-old son Vamos Amigos out of a Hotline-daughter is registered in Westphalia and places second in the world ranking for dressage horses. Once he came to the Schockemöhle station in 2016, his breeding sphere has expanded enormously. Hannoveraner breeders may also have justified hopes for successful dressage horses. He is really breathing down his sire Vivaldi's neck. From a competitive point of view, Vitalis is the best Dutch stallion in the breeding of Hannoveraner dressage horses. The Dutch stallion Bordeaux by United/Gribaldi is one year older, and belongs to the same generation. He is a champion stallion in the Netherlands and was stationed at the Schockemöhle station for many years. With the descendants Bluetooth OLD and Bohemian, both born in 2010, he already produced two real world-class horses. He is not the typical foal producer; his offspring were also not dominant in young horse competitions, but now, when it comes to collection, piaffe and passage, they are on the attack.

A lot happened in the absolute top group of this WBFSH ranking. The Dutch Jazz-son Johnson has regained the top position. If you look at his offspring, you will notice that none is found in the absolute international top group. Rather, he has taken first place because of the large number of his internationally successful descendants. 28 offspring are listed – no other stallion has more. His highest-ranked son Edison is in 34th place, Eddieni has the lowest ranking with 740th place. The fact that this one is also successful in Grand Prix-clas-

ses shows how many horses are now competing internationally at this level. The retired former national champion Quarterback is in second place. He too was not known for producing beautiful young horses, but now made a name for himself as the producer of Grand Prix-horses. With his son DSP Quantas, which Isabell Werth competes (fifth place), and Touchdown (a Swedish Warmblood; seventh place) with Patrik Kittel, he has two horses in the top ten of the world rankings. His third most successful horse is the Hannoveraner Quater Back Junior FRH (rank 45; breeder: Gerd Janssen, Neuschoo), who participated in the Olympic Games in Tokyo and the World Championships in Herning with Nicolas Wagner Ehlinger from Luxembourg. That Quarterback's son Quaterhall (breeder: Ulrich Kriebel, Bienenbüttel; ranked 68th in the WBFSH stallion list) is preparing to follow in his sire's footsteps was shown at the Louisdor-Prize in Frankfurt, where two of his sons qualified for this high-grade final test for rising Grand Prix-horses. In the meantime, Celle's former state stud stallion is active in the USA. The Quaterhall-daughter Quater Girl (breeder: Johann Aldag, Ahlerstedt) is ranked 116th in the world rankings for dressage horses. In France and Belgium, the nine-year-old mare was already victorious in the Grand Prix with her rider Antoine Nowakowski.

With the active support of Hannoveraner breeders, Sir Donnerhall, who is stationed at Paul Schockemöhle's facility, has climbed onto third place in the list of producers. His highest ranked offspring (rank 60) is the nine-year-old American Hannoveraner mare Serenade MF, who might have received her great talent for collection from her dam's sire Don Principe. She was bred by Maryanna Haymon and is ridden by the female US-rider Alice Tarjan. The second most successful offspring of Sir Donnerhall is the Hannoveraner mare Valentine out of the breeding program of Ricarda-Maria Heidmeyer. Valentine's second dam Fähre has the same granddam – Gode – as the Rhineland stallion Florestan. Valentine is also mostly successful in the USA. She won several Grand Prix-classes with Ashley Holzer.

Fidertanz among the top ten

The Hannoveraner Stallion Of The Year 2021, the Rhineland stallion Fidertanz by Fidermark/Ravallo (breeder: Hermann Schult, Hünxe; station: Stallion Station Böckmann, Lastrup), defended his place among the top ten with a seventh place. The Grand Prix-successful Hannoveraner stallions Franziskus FRH, Foundation and Fahrenheit contributed significantly to this ranking. With Fahrenheit, born in 2007 (breeder: Andrea Heitmann, Dinklage) out of a De Niro-dam, a Fidertanz-son is among the top

100 dressage stallions of the WBFSH for the first time. The performances of his eight-year-old, licensed son Flynn (ranked 134 in the world rankings of dressage horses; breeder: Anton Muhr, Bad Rappenau) out of a dam by Sir Oldenburg were certainly conducive to this ranking. With Flore Winne, he already obtained numerous international Grand Prix-placings. Fahrenheit himself is now a gelding.

The highest ranked Hannoveraner stallion in the WBFSH rankings is Verden's former licensing champion Hotline by Hofrat/De Niro (rank 18; breeder: Friedrich Oppermann, Salzgitter), whose main place of activity has been the internationally renowned Danish stud Blue Hors. From that location, he enjoyed international demand. His seven offspring with international successes are registered with six different studbooks. At the end of 2018, the brown moved to Dreamscape Stud in Canada in the greater Vancouver area, where he passed away in February of 2021. The Olympic champion and Hannoveraner Stallion Of The Year 2016, Desperados FRH by De Niro/Wolkenstein II

(breeder: Herbert Schütt, Hemmoor), slipped in the rankings from tenth place to 27th. Six Hannoveraners contributed to his ranking. A great hope is his son Destacado FRH (breeder: Heinrich Gießelmann, Barver), who is currently enjoying a real Grand Prix-winning streak with Matthias Alexander Rath. In last year's ranking, he was in 201st position; in the meantime, he already improved to 35th place. He is one rank behind the Rhineland stallion Lord Leatherdale by Lord Loxley/Ferragamo (breeder: ZG Pleines, Uedem), who succeeded in founding a new stallion line in the Netherlands. His eleven-year-old son Glamourdale (KWPN) has fulfilled the highest expectations as the newly crowned world champion. The hopes for him as a sire are great as well.

A whole series of other Hannoveraner and Rhineland stallions are ranked among the top 100. It is remarkable to find Celle's state stud stallion Hochadel by Hohenstein/Donnerhall (breeder: Hans-Günter Berner, Edendorf) on rank 33. Five of his offspring are listed. He also is a stallion of whom few offspring attracted attention, when they were young. Now, suddenly, some are appearing on the international Grand Prix-stage. The highest ranked in the world rankings is his daughter Havanna on rank 38. With Ashley Holzer, she was not only highly successful at the Grand Prix-level in the USA. Her breeder is Walter Robert, the chairman of the Hannoveraner District Association Hesse/South Germany, who bred her out of a Rodgau-dam. She went to the dressage facility Werndl in Aubenhausen via an auction at the Alsfeld Advent. From there she moved to the USA and placed in the final of the 2022 World Cup.

Class creates quantity

With Quaterback, Sir Donnerhall, Fidertanz and Sandro Hit, four German stallions are among the top ten of the WBFSH stallion rankings, three of them were national champions with Fidertanz as vice national champion, which was an excellent advertisement for the stallions. Class creates the necessary high-quality quantity of offspring – apparently an important prerequisite for enough offspring to place internationally later on, to reach the top of the WBFSH ranking.

World ranking and breeding value estimation have quite different approaches. The world ranking reflects what happens in one year, whereas the breeding value estimation evaluates the lifetime performance of a stallion with the help of a recognized scientific-statistical model. It is also not as dependent on the number of offspring. This means that a stallion can obtain a good breeding value, even if he is used less. ■

Breeding goal realized

After Van Helsing, another stallion from the breeding station of Family Brands in Asendorf near Hamburg was licensed in 2020 and awarded the premium status: It was Zoom In by Zoom.

Van Helsing was already special when he was born in 2007. "I have never seen a foal that stood on its own feet as quickly and powerfully as Van Helsing. At the same time, he looked into the world with a charisma as if he wanted to say 'Here I am, let's go'," This is how breeder Klaus Brandes describes his first encounter with the homebred colt. Two years later, the Valentino-son was licensed in Verden and became a premium stallion. He then changed hands at the stallion market for a six-figure sum and had a career in international show jumping. "I don't sell foals, since I want to see how my breed selections develop, no matter if stallion or mare," the 64-year-old gives an insight into his breeding intentions, which he shares with his life partner Anke Hinrichs (62).

Besides, Klaus Brandes is a little different from other horse breeders. When he secured a non-buildable parcel of land in the residential area of Asendorf near Hamburg in 1990, the then engineer did have the option of keeping horses at the house, but only on a smaller scale. In addition, he was so busy at work that he did not have the time to build up a Hanoverian breeding program on a larger scale. The Brandes-horse breeding program is based on a well thought-out management. Today Klaus Brandes can accommodate up to six horses in three smaller stables, which are located on a sand paddock with direct access to a two-hectare pasture. "I did not strive for more than that. That's why, in the past 30 years, only one to two foals have ever been born on my farm each year. In addition to my job, I wanted to give horses a higher priority in my life again. The breeding of horses was always to remain a hobby though." Since then, a total of 43 horses have been born in Asendorf. And that with a remarkable record: They in-

clude two licensed stallions and various successful show jumpers and dressage horses. "I send my foals to suitable horse farms to be raised. I must be convinced that they are in good hands." Klaus Brandes himself grew up near Peine in a family home where there were no horses; but his grandparents had horses. "My grandfather bred Welsh B-ponies, on which I naturally romped around as a child. Later I learned to ride and gained some horse show experience." Professionally, he then moved to Braunschweig to study mechanical engineering and then to Hamburg, where he worked as an engineer at Mercedes. Since he wanted to be independent and "stand on his own two feet", he then started his own business. "I worked as a management consultant, travelled a lot and helped small and medium-sized companies with their management. Two years ago, I scaled back my involvement a lot and took more care of my private life and the breeding of horses."

At about the same time as he was building his new home in Asendorf, Klaus Brandes met his life partner Anke Hinrichs, who was still active as a rider in the early 1990s and comes from a family of bree-

ders. Her father Joachim Hinrichs traditionally bred Hanoverians in Hamburg. He always researched the market for suitable mares, which was later to benefit his daughter Anke and Klaus Brandes. The purchase of Dujana by Duden II/Gmunden (breeder: Diedrich Höft, Deinste), born in 1969, not only influenced his own breeding operation. With breeding Dujana to Celle's state stud stallion Eisenherz, Joachim Hinrichs bred St.Pr.St. Eljana, born in 1983, who in turn became the dam of the mares Leandra by Lemon Park (1991) and Ancora by Acord II (1993). The breeding program of Klaus Brandes and Anke Hinrichs is ultimately based on these two mares. Both their jumping and dressage bloodlines go back to the genes of these two mares. When Joachim Hinrichs passed away six years ago, the couple also took over the care of the historic Hanoverian dam line of Nordspitze from the year 1882. "Ancora was actually supposed to be Anke's first riding horse out of the family's breeding program. Due to an injury, however, we used her in our breeding program earlier than planned. So I also bought Leandra from Anke's father and trained her myself. She competed until she was six years old and then had her first foal."

Two premium stallions

The development of both mares took a remarkable course. Both Ancora and Leandra passed on their good dispositions and genes – especially to their fillies. Already in the second generation, their daughters Stakkora by Stakkato and Wariandra by Waterford each produced a premium stallion. The fastest success was achieved in the jumping-oriented bloodline. Breeding Stakkora (born 2001) to the state stud stallion Valentino resulted in the birth of Van Helsing in 2007, who has been the figurehead of the Brandes-breeding program so far. The meanwhile 17-year-old has already had an eventful curriculum vitae. After his licensing, Van Helsing moved to the then up-and-coming Famos Stud, caused a sensation with his rider Karl Brooks and received top marks at his performance test in Neustadt/Dosse. With the Belgian Brecht Bille, he took part in the World Championships for young show jumpers. Afterwards, Vincent Voorn, Roosje Brouwer and Denis Lynch climbed into his saddle. With Denis Lynch, he finished second in the Grand Prix of Dortmund in 2017. Van Helsing's most recent successes were with the young Swiss rider Flaminia Straumann. Due to his sporting career, Van Helsing was only sporadically used for breeding. Nevertheless, as a sire he passed on his genes to such highly predisposed show jumpers as Van Moor or Vertigo WAF. "I am definitely considering using Van Helsing in my own breeding program. His presence and his jumping ability are undisputed. He has also proven that he passes on his

exceptional potential. As a large-framed show jumper, he only sometimes lacked the decisive tenths of a second to win. His genes are a perfect match for one of my lively and blood-influenced broodmares," says Klaus Brandes. He often had been right in his choice of sires. Anke Hinrichs certainly also had a great influence on this. "For me, the decisions to breed to some stallions were a matter of the heart and arose from a gut feeling." For example, she had already recommended Acord II to her dad and therefore also wanted to have the mare Ancora as a riding horse. It was a similar story with the use of the stallions Valentino and Zoom. These stallions had one thing in common: They were still young and inexperienced.

"When Zoom In was born, we were all very excited because he was part of Zoom's first foals. Of course, there is a risk involved in using young stallions. But we have had good experiences with it. Zoom In is more of a late developer, but as a two-year-old, he totally convinced me with his ground-covering hindquarters." At his 2020 licensing in Verden, Heike Kemmer described the stallion as follows: "He always wants to do everything right and he can do it. All three gaits are at the highest level, relaxed, ground covering, very balanced and rhythmic."

For some years now, Klaus Brandes sends his young horses to the family business of Peter Mahler in Neuhaus/Oste to raise and train them. With the perfect preparation for the licensing, the horse farm justified the trust that was placed in it. After all, equine manager Kerstin Mahler as the best presenter contributed to Zoom In becoming a premium stallion and being sold very lucratively at the subsequent stallion market to Helgstrand Dressage, who passed him on to the Swedish stud called Lövsta Stuteri.

"Actually, I have already achieved my breeding goals with the two licensed stallions. Both are premium stallions, and Van Helsing has also made it into international show jumping," Klaus Brandes is quite satisfied with his breeding successes. But he is not thinking of stopping yet. For his partner Anke Hinrichs, it looks a bit different: After almost 30 years of breeding horses and working a job, she would like to spend a little more time with her partner. The camper is already waiting. The only problem is finding someone to take care of the horses while they are away. That is becoming more and more difficult. Nevertheless, a longer stay in Norway is planned. In addition, the bus is ideally suited for uncomplicated overnight stays at the venue of multi-day stallion inspections, mare or foal shows. ■

Global Hope by Global Player/Fidertanz (breeder: ZG Werth, Moers), Vivino II BG by Vivaldi/Dancier (breeder: Ulrike Buurman, Greifenstein), Zalazar by Zackerey/Dancier (breeder: Guido Kamphorst,

Nordhorn) and a chestnut by Zackerey/Flo-riscount (breeder: Friedel Cordes, Süderwal-sede) were licensed for Westphalia.

The Oldenburg stallion days took place in **Vechta** in mid-January. The Farrell/Livaldon son Federer (breeder: Wienke Winkelmann, Wurster Nordseeküste) was the main premium winner. Gerd Sosath had secured the dark bay stallion from the dam line of Stange, which also produced the Burgpokal winner Comic FRH, three years ago at the stallion sales in Verden. Oldenburg-International awarded a Dia Corrado/Lord Pezi son (breeder: Jörn Kusel, Visselhövede) with the Ic premium. In addition, Captain Pezi by Cicero Z/ Lord Pezi (breeder: Johannes zur Lage, Ber-senbrück) was licensed. A dark bay by Zackerey/Londonderry (breeder: Andrea Eilfort-Böcker, Ankum) received a positive licensing for Oldenburg. ■
