





# MARES REWARDED FOR COMPETITION SUCCESS

In Heather Petersen's case, her mare, Worthy Aspirations (Worthy Opponent x Dominica V/Don Frederico), almost missed qualifying for the Competition Mare title years ago.

The Competition Mare (CM) title almost seems like one of the American Hanoverian Society's best-kept secrets—perhaps because it's based on performance requirements that can take years to achieve. It's not easy to achieve, but extremely rewarding for those who earn it with their horses.

In Heather Petersen's case, her mare, Worthy Aspirations (Worthy Opponent x Dominica V/Don Frederico), almost missed qualifying for the CM title years ago.

Heather found Worthy Aspirations, barn name Ruby, at five months old. Bred by Genna Gatdula, Ruby was the 45th young horse Heather looked at either in person or by video. "I loved Ruby's attitude in the pictures and videos and, of course, her gaits," says Heather.

When Ruby was five months old, her tendon sheath became infected. "There was no visible trauma to the area, and to this day, the vets have no idea how the sheath became

infected," explains Heather. "After six weeks in the ICU, they sent her home with a 10 percent chance of pasture soundness. We continued with IV antibiotics for another six weeks with our local vet before we made the decision that her quality of life was comprised, and it was time to let her go.

"We made this decision on a Friday evening. The insurance company asked us to wait until Monday when the adjusters were back in the office. That Monday, when we pulled the final set of bloodwork to send to the insurance company with the paperwork, the infection was completely gone! Three weeks later, she was 100% sound, back to her normal self. Every day I have with her is a blessing."

Not only did Ruby survive, but has moved up the levels and is progressing toward Grand Prix. "Feeling the connection through her back and to the contact brings me joy," says Heather. "Ruby becomes very proud the more we work and loves praise for her efforts. It's wonderful to see how much she enjoys the work—almost as much as she loves trail rides and gallops."

Besides the pride Heather feels in training a horse up through the levels (especially considering the serious medical issue), an added bonus for Heather is Ruby met the Hanoverian inspection requirements this winter

and is thinking about trying embryo transfer.

"I'm truly blessed to have this mare in my life," says Heather. "It's been wonderful to learn more about the Hanoverian breed through her. I bought a young horse a couple of years ago—also a Hanoverian. I'm loving the

community this breed has created."

Dawn Frazer, owner of Wind Phaerie HU (Wild Dance x Pikk Diva HU/Pik L), bred by Horses Unlimited, Inc., learned about the Competition Mare title when she was reading the 2023 issue of the AHS Awards Magazine. "I had already started to compete Willow (barn name) at Fourth Level, so I decided to get the final scores needed to qualify by the end of the 2023 show season," says Dawn. "I always need a riding goal. I had already earned my USDF Silver Medal on my prior horse, so this came at a good time. Goals always make me push a little harder to develop both myself and my horse."

Dawn bought Willow in 2019 before the start of COVID. "I had seen her advertised for several months and was intrigued, as she was 15.2h and I'm 5' 2," explains Dawn. "I'm located in Massachusetts, and she was in Florida. Due to her price and the distance, I did not immediately fly down for a test ride. When I did, I knew she was just the right size, and she felt like a sports car."

Willow lives at a farm located behind Dawn's house. "She is always happy to see me and eager to work," says Dawn. "She's very sweet and calm as we prepare for work, but

she can be a little distracted and overly observant of the surroundings under saddle. She will follow me anywhere with or without a lead—she just walks behind me through all things scary. She is particularly bothered by changes in footing. At shows

you will see us wandering over obstacles the day before in hopes that she learns all is safe. Sometimes this works, and sometimes you'll see us stop at rubber mat near the ring's entrance, and then she decides to get on with her job and jumps from a standstill to clear the mat. The extra adrenaline rush always makes for a super test."

Even with her safety antenna up, Dawn said Willow is a worker bee and tries her hardest to learn and perform what is being asked. She said her goals are to progress to Grand Prix and earn her USDF Gold Medal: "She is making steady progress—the dream is still alive!"



#### FEI LEVEL

It isn't often you have a breeder, owner and rider take a horse all the way up the levels to Grand Prix, but that's the case with Ramora CF and Kimberly Kobryn-Callaway.

And, there's more. While breeding and training her through every level in dressage, Kimberly also has planned for the future by doing embryo transfer with Ramora and has three of her foals for her future riding horses.

Kimberly says Ramora (aka Heart) is fun to ride and train because she's extremely light and sensitive to the aids. "She was not so easy as a young horse for these reasons, and also lacked confidence. but because I've been her only rider, we have a very definite language. I can think

something, and she'll do it," says Kimberly. "She has the best work ethic."

A successful producer (with plans for more embryo transfers), a successful performance horse (with the goal of riding in a CDI at Grand Prix) and a wonderful temperament (Heart loves going on trail rides), Kimberly sums up the bond between the two of them: "Heart has been a very generous horse to me in so many ways."

Holly Taylor has been riding and training Baileys H since he was three years old. She says he has a funny, opinionated and red-head personality, but "he tries as hard as he can to understand what I want in the training."

Holly says she trusts Baileys H 100% when she rides him, and he's been reliable in every show location and test he's done—except one.

At one show he decided bucking and being playful in every test was the answer. "It took firm discussion mid-test to get him to recognize this was not acceptable behavior," said Holly. "Unfortunately

it happened during a regional championship ride!"

Holly also finds humor in his pre-show ritual of getting feisty in his stall just after he's braided, but before he's tacked up. "He bounces around, snorting and pawing," says Holly,

"but as soon as the tack goes on, he's all business."

Holly's future plans for Baileys is to "continue to develop this special horse up the levels as far as he wants to go, and I believe he'll go all the way."

### GREENGATE FARM AWARD OPEN FEI

The **Greengate Award**,, established in 2019 by Rachel and Warren Ehrlich of Greengate Farm, honors the breeder of an American-born horse that is a high-score winner at the US Dressage Finals at the National and FEI levels.

For the second year in a row, Lady in Red WS (ES Liberty Gold x EM Winessa/PB DeNiro) has earned this award for Jan and Gary Marquardt of Walkabout Station.

"We're quite honored to be the recipients of the Greengate Farm, which honors the breeders of American-born horses," said Jan. "Quite frankly, this award is equally shared with our partner and trainer, Heather McCarthy, who started, rides and trains Lady in Red.

"For us, the answer is to have a connection between the horses we breed and the buyers," says Jan. "We truly hope to be able to help buyers choose their next partner in sport so they too can be successful as they go up the levels. Breeders offer the first step in the lifelong equestrian journey. Gary and I love watching our foals become the athletes we dream of."

Jan says Rachel and Warren Ehrlich deserve a huge thanks for initiating this award at the registry level. "As an American breeder, it's so rewarding to receive this award because it highlights the growth that American breeders have put into their programs both from a mare

and stallion level," says Jan.
"As time goes by, we hope
it will showcase the fact that

### GREENGATE FARM AWARD ADULT AMATEUR USDF NATIONAL LEVEL

The **Greengate Award**, established in 2019 by Rachel and Warren Ehrlich of Greengate Farm, honors the breeder of an American-born horse that is a high-score winner at the US Dressage Finals at the National and FEI levels.

Roxy Lee HA was her dam EM Halleluja HA's seventh foal and third in-utero foal that Cheryl and Eric Johnson sold to Ruth Shirkey during their 20 years of Hanoverian breeding. Using Revolution for a sire, their plans were to produce a foal with a longer leg and an improved canter without losing the dam's high rideability, intelligence, elasticity, suppleness and superb walk and trot. Roxy Lee was one of the resulting foals.

"Roxy Lee represents a breeder's dream and represents the second generation of our breeding program," says Cheryl. "We imported Roxy's maternal granddam, EM Radunja by Rosentau/Weltmeyer from Germany, as our foundation broodmare. We bred Radunja to His Highness to produce Roxy's dam, Halleluja, who represented seven direct generations of Elite/ Premium Hanoverian mares who were champions of their Mare Performance Tests."

Cheryl has remained close to Ruth since 2010, when she purchased her first foal from them, EMC Wyleigh Princess (Weltmeyer x His Highness/Matcho). A USDF Gold Medalist, Ruth raised, trained and competed Wyleigh Princess through Grand Prix. "Ruth's commitment to her horses and the sport is unwavering," says Cheryl. "She has made the trek from California to Kentucky and Illinois to compete in the US Dressage Finals and Festival of Champions multiple times."

#### ROXY LEE HA

Revolution x Halleluja H.A./ His Highness

Roxy Lee headed from Michigan to California in early 2019 after weaning. "As our friendship has grown, Ruth and I speak weekly," says Cheryl. "Ruth often sends video links to me, so I can see Roxy's training and competition progress. I feel privileged to have access to this knowledge sharing. To date, Roxy and two of her half siblings, also out of Halleluja, have competed in the US Dressage Finals, resulting in top ten placements."

Cheryl and Eric decided to stop breeding in 2020 in preparation for their retirements. "We had to make decisions regarding our broodmares—including Roxy's dam, Halleluja," says Cheryl. "Because our intent was to never sell them, we decided to start them under saddle for my enjoyment. How lucky was I to have such beautiful and talented dressage talent in my own back yard! I enjoy riding her, her granddam Radunja (until her passing in 2022) and her aunt EM Havannah L."

## GREENGATE FARM AWARD JUNIOR/YOUNG RIDER USDF NATIONAL LEVEL

The **Greengate Award**, established in 2019 by Rachel and Warren Ehrlich of Greengate Farm, honors the breeder of an American-born horse that is a high-score winner at the US Dressage Finals.

This award is bestowed posthumously to Otto Rudolf Fuchs who bred Lyon at Hilton Farm. For this reason, we interviewed the new owner and rider of Lyon.

Lyon had a rough few years before Lori Wolf found him. After his breeder, Otto Rudolf Fuchs of Hilton Farm, passed away, Lyon was sold twice, the second time for \$1 to live with donkeys in New Mexico. When Lori found him, he was very skittish and couldn't be ridden under saddle because he was 300 lbs. underweight. "My daughter, Autumn, worked with him for the past four years, and they have become a fabulous team,"

says Lori. "I'm sure Otto Fuchs, who also owned his sire, Liberty Gold, would be happy that Lyon received a second chance and a loving, young girl to train him."

"I've seen a complete change in personality and demeanor over the years," says Autumn. "He's also very friendly and cuddly, gives his all on a day-to-day basis, is confident and level-headed—which is a huge help at shows. He's also particularly fond of treats!"

Autumn's plans for Lyon include moving up the levels in dressage, earning her USDF Bronze medal and working on her first freestyle.

"Lyon has a constellation of cowlicks on his forehead, " says Autumn. "I like to say the stars brought him to me."

## THE PREMONITION BHF TROPHY

The **Premonition BHF Perpetual Trophy** goes each year to the highest placing Hanoverian in the hunter division. The award is named in honor of Premonition BHF (Pablo x SPS Galaxis/Ganymed), the inaugural winner of this award in 2017.

As an active breeding stallion and beloved companion to his owner, Stephanie Hill, Baloujoie is described as having that "it" factor in the hunter ring and everywhere they go. "As a show hunter, it's really nice to ride a horse, stallion or otherwise, that everywhere I go, trainers and amateurs come up to me and volunteer that Baloujoie is, conformationally, the prettiest hunter they have ever seen. It's exhilarating to ride and show a horse that everyone admires due to his looks," says Stephanie. "In addition to having lovely hunter jumping form, I like that he's a hack class winner. In my 50+ years of riding and showing, I have never had a more stunning horse to show in the hunter ring."

This beautiful bay stallion was bred by Chris and Tara Lambie of Alberta, Canada. Stephanie's husband, Tom, has been Baloujoie's primary handler and trainer from his darling foal days to the accomplished stallion he is today. Tom's training focus for Baloujoie was to "ensure Baloujoie was no different in handling than a mare or a gelding," says Stephanie. "One thing Tom succeeded in was to train Baloujoie to trailer with mares. We have traveled cross country in our head-to-head, fourhorse trailer with mares across the aisle, and Baloujoie acts like a gentleman"—a trait not often trusted in most breeding stallions.

At home, Baloujoie is called "Mr. B" to give credit to his quiet, laid back and happy daily temperament. As further testament to his registered name, Stephanie lovingly says, "Nothing bothers him. He has such a quiet, kind, willing nature, and is a joy to be around. Mr. B will do anything we ask, without hesitation or second thought. His first response is to please." These traits certainly contribute to his success in the hunter ring, where he has taken home numerous wins in the 3'3" classes, as well as earning top-scoring Jumper Stallion at the 2018 East Coast North American Stallion Sport Test.

## THE HILLTOP FARM, INC. YOUNG DRESSAGE HORSE AWARD

This award, sponsored by Hilltop Farm, celebrates the highest scoring Hanoverian or Rhineland young dressage horse competing in the USEF 4-year-old and the 5- and 6-year-old classes.

Denmark HTF, a 2019 Hanoverian stallion bred and owned by Hilltop Farm, Inc., had an excellent show season last year, culminating in earning the title of American Hanoverian Society (AHS) Champion in the USEF/FEI Young Horse divisions. As he was only 4 years old last year, Denmark's show season was kept deliberately light. He competed at only five competitions, yet still earned a median score of 8.1 in the 4-year old young horse tests, competed at the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) Championships and secured an impressive fourth place in the United States Dressage Federation (USDF) year-end standings.

One of Denmark's most endearing qualities is his affable nature. Described as personable and kind, he has a penchant for morning naps, a trait that even horse shows cannot deter. Michael Bragdell, who has the privilege of training Denmark, praises the stallion's delightful temperament and aptitude for learning, stating, "Denmark is a lot of fun to train and rides very much like his half-brother Louisville. Denmark is very smart and wants to please. His canter is a highlight for me and really shows the capacity to sit and collect already."

As with most of Hilltop's stallions, Denmark is having to do double-duty, as he is also

an active breeding stallion.

"Denmark has received a lot of interest from the breeders as well," says Brittany Callahan, Hilltop's Breeding Manager.

"We're excited to welcome his first foals this spring including one of our own out of a For Romance/Qredit mare."

Looking ahead to the 2024 season, Denmark and his team have ambitious goals in mind. He will again have a full breeding season and shows will be carefully chosen to minimize the impact on breeders. They aim to qualify once again for the US Young Horse National Championships, while also completing his stallion performance requirements, either through competition or participation in the North American Stallion Sport Test in the fall.

"I could not have had the opportunities I have without Rolex, my parents and my trainers! I hope to take Rolex to college with me when I figure out where I am going to attend. My plan is to join the collegiate eventing team and hope to compete in the Intercollegiate Eventing Championships."

Her sire, Franziskus, was a Bundeschampionate winner in his early career and has achieved numerous CDI\*4 Grand Prix placings with renowned Olympic rider, Ingrid Klimke, and is under consideration for the German team for the Paris Olympics. Her dam, HPM Rebellienne HVH, was USEF Young Horse Dressage Champion at age four and USDFBC HOY Materiale at age three." Adding to the strength of her ancestry, Franziska's aunt, Radiance HVH, was also a Dr. Walter Hartwig Memorial Trophy winner in 2010.

"Franziska is a wonderful blend of her dressage parents, demonstrating quality gaits, presence and exceptional character," remarks Annetta.

Franziska is blazing her path to future stardom. In addition to winning the Dr. Hartwig Memorial Trophy, Franziska began her performance career showing in the USDF three-year-old materiale classes, where she placed fourth in the national USDFBC Horse of the Year under High Valley's trainer, Olivia Torres.

"Franziska is a beautiful, talented mare with a very personable, loving temperament," says Annetta. "She was a happy filly growing up, is very focused while at work, composed in the show ring, super happy in her group paddock and easily one of our barn's favorites." Annetta says Franziska will return to her performance career after weaning her 2024 foal, and will continue to produce Hanoverian offspring via embryo transfer.

As a foal, Jhuno (Jovian-Sanatana/Sandro Hit) was tall, elegant and "just lifted herself off the ground from the very first steps," says Mo. "We had to wait for that balance to return, while she went through the awkward growth phases. She finally stopped growing at 17.3 hands. Fortunately, she's not wide, so she's perfectly proportioned for a woman rider."

Jhuno is named after the Roman goddess of marriage. (Adding the "h" as the second letter is a tradition for Mo's breeding program going back to 1996.) Jhuno is sweet, polite in her space and enjoys interacting with her

humans. Mo says Jhuno was easy to start under saddle and that her "canter is especially lovely."

Mo says after breeding warmbloods for 45 years, she and her husband are heading into retirement, so Jhuno is for sale. If it wasn't for that, Mo would put Jhuno in her breeding program because of her gaits, high rideability and pedigree with four generations of states premium mares.







As a basis for upgrading a mare to a higher studbook or granting the title of Hanoverian Premium Mare, the following performance alternatives apply: 1) a mare performance test, or 2) performance in sport.

In 2023, Beau's Emergence was the sole mare who achieved through performance an upgrade from Studbook to Main Studbook.






# NON-HANOVERIAN/NON-RHINELAND INSPECTION SITE CHAMPION MARES

# HANOVERIAN AND RHINELAND PREMIUM MARE CANDIDATES

RANKED BY SCORE

The Mare Performance Test (MPT) assesses the rideability of mares and whether their talent lies in jumping or dressage.

The results provide key evidence for informed breeding decisions. Mares who achieve a MPT score of 7.0 or better or meet the sports requirements earn the Premium Mare Candidate status. In 2023, a total of 46 mares participated in the MPT with 31 earning Hanoverian Premium Mare Candidate (HPMC), Rhineland Premium Mare Candidate (RPMC) or non-Hanoverian/non-Rhineland (PMC) status. An additional two mares earned Premium Mare Candidate status through sport results in 2023.






















