# GPS will not always get you to the right location or takes you on a circuitous route!

#### From Denton area:

Take 380 west to Bridgeport. In Bridgeport, Turn L onto 114. Take a R on 114 when it T's into business 114. Leaving Bridgeport there is a long curve and at the bottom of the hill take a R onto FM 2123. Go about 7 miles and turn R onto CR 3550. In 1 mile the road will make a left, but you will turn R into our rock entrance.

### From Dallas, Flower Mound area:

Go west on 114. It will merge **briefly** (for about a mile) onto 287, then take the exit to Bridgeport. Turn L onto 114. Go 10 miles. Go L onto FM 51 (goes under 114). Go about 2 miles and turn R onto FM 2123. Go 10 miles and turn L onto CR 3550. In 1 mile the road will make a left, but you will turn R into our rock entrance.

## From Weatherford, Springtown, west Fort Worth

From Springtown, (at intersection of 199) go north on FM 51. In 8 miles, turn L onto FM 2123. (If you get to 114, you have gone too far) Go 10 miles and turn L onto CR 3550. In 1 mile the road will make a left, but you will turn R into our rock entrance.

## From Waxahachie, Mansfield,

Take 287 North (depending on time of day, would recommend taking the toll road) It will merge with I35 W north. Continue on 287 north of FW. Take the 114 exit and go turn L. **Go 10 miles**. Go L onto FM 51 (goes under 114). Go about 2 miles and turn R onto FM 2123. **Go 10 miles** and turn L onto CR 3550. In 1 mile the road will make a left, but you will turn R into our rock entrance.
